Genesis 24:1-10

Genesis 24 is the longest chapter in Genesis. Biblical Narrative A Complete Account that Should Be Read And Studied In One Setting.

A servant was sent by Abraham to select a wife for his son Isaac. (Scripture Reveals The Providence of God) Proverbs 3:6

Why This Passage Is Important: Because a bride is chosen to carry on the bloodline of the Messiah and the people of Israel.

Why This Passage Is Important: Isaac (Son) is a picture of Jesus Christ, Abraham (Father) is a picture of **God The Father**, and the Servant is a picture of the **Holy Spirit** that is seeking out a bride for Christ. (Church)

Why This Passage Is Important: This passage speaks of the importance of marriage, and the importance of the preparation of marriage.

1. Verses 1-9 Servant's Charge:

Genesis 24:1 Now Context – The death and burial of Sarah

Genesis 23:19-20

Abraham was old, advanced in age; Abraham was 140. (Genesis 25:20 Isaac 40) He was 100 when Isaac was born. Abraham died in **Genesis 25:7,** 35 years later. 175 dies.

and the LORD had blessed Abraham in every way. Abraham walked by faith.

Genesis 24:2 Abraham said to his servant, 12 times "servant" Who was this servant? We don't know for sure, but it is suggested that it was Eliezer – "Helper" of Damascus. (Genesis 15:2 50-60 years earlier, may have died) **John 14:15-21** The helper the Holy Spirit.

"Please place your hand under my thigh, Genesis 47:29 Jacob and Joseph, ensure prosperity.

Genesis 24:3 I will make you swear by the LORD, the <u>God of heaven</u> and the <u>God of earth</u>, The great distinction between the true and false gods, God is the creator.

daughters of the Canaanites, among whom I live, Pagan people of the land.

Abraham was living among them but <u>not part of them</u>. This is <u>not Racial/Skin but a Spiritual/Heart</u>.

1 Corinthians 7:39 "only in the Lord" 2 Corinthians 6:14 <u>Do not be</u> bound together with unbelievers;

Genesis 24:4 but you will go to my country and to my relatives, and take a wife for my son Isaac." From the line of Shem.

Genesis 22:20,23 mentions Abraham's brother

Genesis 24:5 Should I take Isaac back to Babylon to the place that God told you to leave?

Genesis 24:6 Then Abraham said to him, "Beware that you do not take my son back there! God had made a covenant with Abraham and his seed, with Canaan.

The walk of faith was to be in the promised land of Canaan, the place of promise.

Genesis 24:7 He will send His angel before you, and you will take a wife for my son from there. Abraham trusted God for the future. (Promises) Genesis 18

Genesis 24:8-9 master – used **19 times** should be our attitude towards the Lord.

The more we meditate on God's Word, the more truth we will understand

2. Verses 10-27 Servant's Journey:

Genesis 24:10 Camels walk 3 mph., 500-mile trip.

Genesis 24:11 time when women go out to draw water. Bangladesh, India the women carry these large containers of water. They hang out and talk.

Genesis 24:12 servant is praying, later in Verse 27 He gives praise

Genesis 24:13 "Behold, I am standing by the spring, conversational prayer 1 Thessalonians 5:17 pray without ceasing

Genesis 24:14 'Drink, and I will water your camels also'—may she be the one This sign from the Lord coincided with the <u>virtues</u> that this wife needed to possess.

- 1. The bride needs to be strong and healthy to make the journey:
- 2. The bride needs to be a servant: Be gracious and considerate because she would deal with servants and people of the land.

Whom You have appointed Let God choose the spouse for us!

Matthew 19:6 What therefore God has joined together, let no man separate."

Genesis 24:15 Isaiah 65:24 that before they call, I will answer;

Genesis 24:16-19 A camel that is thirsty can drink up to 50 gallons of water, there are 10 camels. If her jar was 3 gallons, that was 166 trips.

Genesis 24:20-21 The servant just watches her! Ephesians 3:20

Genesis 24:22-23 gold ring weighing a half-shekel (\$500) and two bracelets for her wrists weighing ten shekels in gold, (\$10,000)

"Whose daughter are you? That is the question of all questions!

Genesis 24:24-27 We often forget to thank the Lord Psalm 37:23

3. Verses 28-60 Servant's Priority:

Genesis 24:28-29 Laban – Jacob marries two of his daughters. This guy is a real crook. (Carnal Christian) **Genesis 29-31**

Genesis 24:30-31 And he said, "Come in, blessed of the LORD! Later, he tries to stop her from going with him. He saw the gifts. Worldly I have prepared the house, and a place for the camels?" Hospitality

Genesis 24:32-33 a man that was not only a man <u>of prayer</u> but <u>of action</u>.

Genesis 24:34-36 he has given him all that he has. God the Father has given all over to the Son.

Verses 37-48 The Servant Recounts What The Lord Has Done:

Genesis 24:49-53 The servant brought out articles of silver and articles of gold, and garments, and gave them to Rebekah; Every believer is given gifts. Revelation 19:8

Genesis 24:54-56 Send me away that I may go to my master." God arranged all we must continue. Delayed obedience is disobedience.

Genesis 24:57-58 And she said, "I will go." This was her faith that she demonstrates towards the Lord. **Will we follow Jesus Christ?**

Genesis 24:59-60 What a prophetic statement this was.

4. Verses 61-67 Servant's Rest:

Genesis 24:61 Then Rebekah arose with her maids, Deborah Genesis 35:8

Genesis 24:62 Israel's southern border.

63 Isaac went out to meditate in the field toward evening; Model for singleness.

Proverbs 18:22 He who finds a wife finds a good thing, The word **finds –** "*To come across along the way"*

Genesis 24:64 lifted up her eyes, She was looking to her husband. <u>We need to be looking to Jesus.</u>

Genesis 24:65 Matthew 25:6 'Behold, the bridegroom! Come out to meet him.'

Rebekah Prepared Herself: Then she took her veil and covered herself. Custom for women to cover their face before a man, not in their family.

Genesis 24:66-67 and he <u>loved her</u>; 1st mention of marital love in the Bible.
