1. Verses 1-6 Blessings:

Genesis 39:1 Now Joseph had been taken down to Egypt; Context – Genesis 38 This is in contrast of Judah. We see Joseph's brother falling to temptation, lusting after a Canaanite—prostitution—and Joseph's resistance to temptation. Genesis 37:36 (age 17)

Egypt – in Scripture, is a picture of the World. Egypt had over 2,000 gods

and Potiphar, an Egyptian officer of Pharaoh, the captain of the bodyguard,

He was the overseer of Pharaoh's personal bodyguard in charge of the official executions.

Genesis 39:2 LORD was with Joseph, Notice this phrase is used **four times**

2 LORD was with Joseph,

3 <u>LORD was with him</u>

21 LORD was with Joseph

23 LORD was with him:

so he became a <u>successful man</u>. And he was in the house of his master, the Egyptian.

Joseph is now in his mid-twenties. Successful because God was with him

Genesis 39:3 master saw that the LORD was with him

This would mean that <u>Joseph had to have shared</u>, or <u>given a witness</u>, that <u>he loved the Lord</u>.

and how the LORD caused all that he did to prosper in his hand.

Genesis 39:4 So Joseph found favor in his sight, Serving God and trusting Him.

all that he owned he put in his charge.

Joseph the Trusted man. Personal Assistant.

Genesis 39:5 The blessing of God had been promised by God on Abraham's descendants. **(Genesis 12:1-3)**

the LORD blessed the Egyptian's house on account of Joseph; Joseph was the blessed man. Psalm 1:1-3

Genesis 39:6 So he left everything he owned in Joseph's charge;

God causes growth by giving us a job to do and people to obey. Before we can lead, we need to follow.

Now Joseph was handsome in form and appearance. Next difficulty in Joseph's life.

2. Verses 7-19 Temptations:

Genesis 39:7 It came about after these events

That Joseph is in God's favor. He is a blessing to his master and has been elevated to oversight over his master's property.

Temptation often follows great blessings!

that his master's wife <u>looked with desire</u> at Joseph, "look up and carry away"

and she said, "Lie with me." "come to bed with me"

"Lie with me." "Sin lies not in being tempted, but in yielding to it!"

Unnatural Temptation – would be murder, God never intended man to kill

Natural Temptations – Eating is natural, overeating is not, sleep is natural

Proverbs 23:27 an adulterous woman is a narrow well.

She was degrading Joseph to a thing instead of a person. People call it "Love"

1 Thessalonians 4:6 that no man transgress and defraud

NLT Proverbs 5:15-18 Fornication and adultery change a pure river into a sewer

Genesis 39:8 But he refused

Decision that we must make before the temptation.

Five Reasons Why Joseph Would Not Give In To Temptation:

1. Joseph Was Trusted By His Master: and he has put all that he owns in my charge. Don't violate a person's trust:

Genesis 39:9

- 2. Master's Wife Was The Master's Wife: and he has withheld nothing from me except you, because you are his wife. That she was off limits because she belonged to another. Proverbs 6:27-33
- **3. Joseph Knew He Was A Man Of God: How then could <u>I</u>** How can I, who have been called by God, blessed by God

How then could I, <u>see ourselves as sons and daughters of God.</u> <u>property of Jesus Christ.</u>

- 4. Adultery Is Great Evil: How then could I do this great evil, "wickedness, depravity"
- 5. Adultery Is A Sin Against God: and sin against God?"

The greatest deterrent to sexual sin or any sin is to see sin as being sin against God. Exodus 20:14; Hebrews 13:4

Genesis 39:10 As she spoke to Joseph day after day, This temptation was daily

he did not <u>listen to her</u>

Flirting with the opposite sex, dialoging.

to <u>lie beside her</u> or <u>be with her</u>.

This was a compromise to just lie beside her. There is nothing to it. **Job 31:1; James 1:13-16** God does not tempt us!

Couples Living Together Is Wrong: <u>lie beside her</u> or <u>be with her</u>.

1 Thessalonians 5:22 abstain from every form (appearance) of evil.

or be with her.

Just spending time with her. Not being accountable with the time. **Genesis 39:11 he went into the house to do his work**The temptation came

none of the men of the household was there inside. Satan knows when to strike!

Genesis 39:12 "Lie with me!" Proverbs 7:6-27

And he left his garment (cloak, robe) in her hand and fled, and went outside.

Was this the cowardly thing to do? NO! it was the wise thing to do.

Paul told young Timothy a young Pastor:

2 Timothy 2:22 Now flee from youthful lusts, That means "Fly away!"

Joseph exhibited "Self-control." Proverbs 25:28

Genesis 39:13 Talk about having wounded pride and being humiliated!

Genesis 39:14

"See, <u>he has brought in</u> a Hebrew to us to make sport of us; husbands' fault!

and I screamed.

What you need to do if you get into a real-life situation.

Genesis 39:15-16

Circumstantial evidence of his garment next to her. (Interpret 2 ways)

Genesis 39:17-19 Potiphar was angry because of how he trusted Joseph

3. Verses 20-23 Injustice:

Genesis 39:20 master took him and put him into the jail, But God was with Joseph.

king's prisoners were confined;

Joseph will then meet the butler and the baker.

and he was there in the jail.

There is no promise that if you do everything right you will never have difficulties!

(Joseph did not defend himself – **Isaiah 53:7; 1 Peter 2:19-23**)

Genesis 39:21 But the LORD was with Joseph

This makes the difference in all the world.

Joseph's Rapid Advancements Assured Him God Was With Him, But His Immediate Results Of Obedience Were Unpleasant:

Genesis 39:22 Now we have Joseph the jailbird in charge of all the other jailbirds.

Genesis 39:23 the prisoner was not even supervised. Trustee

Application:

- 1. Joseph's Life Is A Reminder That Temptation Often Follows Great Blessings. So We Need To Be On Guard.
- 2. Being A Child Of God Is A Commitment To Being Pure. Decide Now Before Temptation Comes.
- 3. We Live In A World That Is Consistently Redefining What God Has Called Sin. Joseph Called Adultery "sin against God".
- 4. We Read Four Times **LORD was with Joseph**, Joseph's Rapid Advancements Assured Him God Was With Him, But His Immediate Results Of Obedience Were Unpleasant.
