One Of The Most Beloved Passages In The Bible: Romans 8:28 "From Prison To Palace, To 2<sup>nd</sup> To Pharaoh In An Hour."

Joseph Models How Daily Faithfulness In The Ordinary Duties Is The Best Preparation For Future Service. "Now Prison To Palace!"

**Thought Of Our Passage:** "Adversity, Prosperity Or Exultation Did Not Affect Joseph's Trust And Witness In God Whom He Served."

#### 1. Verses 1-8 Pharaoh Dreams

Genesis 41:1 Now it happened at the end of two full years.

**Context -** Moses left off with Joseph in prison, where he interpreted two dreams: one for the **Cupbearer** and one for the **Baker**. He then tells the cupbearer who would be restored to his position. **Genesis 40:14-15** 

What Joseph said came true, and the cupbearer was restored **Genesis 40:23**, **Genesis 41:1 Now it happened at the end of two full years** 

"Our stops as well as our steps are ordered by God." Psalm 37:23

(Joseph, 17 when sold to slavery, now 30 (Genesis 41:46), as he stands before Pharaoh, 13 years have gone by) Philippians 1:6

Verses 1-4 Pharaoh's First Dream - Cattle: that Pharaoh had a dream, Pharaoh had two dreams. Behind the scenes, God is working!

and behold, he was standing by the Nile. Nile – a god, giver of life. God of Fertility.

Genesis 41:2-4 ugly and gaunt cows ate up the seven sleek and fat cows - This could only happen in a dream! Cows eating up cows.

Verses 5-7 Pharaoh's Second Dream - Grain: Genesis 41:5 (Grain (not Corn), a great asset of the Egyptians).

Genesis 41:6-7 thin ears swallowed up the seven plump and full ears. This again could only happen in a dream.

**Then Pharaoh awoke, -** The word "behold" is used six times, it shook the king to his core.

**Genesis 41:8 Now in the morning his spirit was troubled,** - He realized that this was some divine message from God.

magicians of Egypt, - students of the occult. "Lector-Priests" learned in sacred writings, rituals, and spells at temple schools. Moses would encounter this same group. **Exodus 7:11** 

**and all its wise men.** Philosophers who had books and formulas on dreams.

#### 2. Verses 9-13 Cupbearer Remembers

Genesis 41:9 Remembers two years later, something! Genesis 41:10-13

#### 3. Verses 14-32 Joseph Interprets

Genesis 41:14 Then Pharaoh sent and called for Joseph, God can change things in a moment.

## he had shaved himself and changed his clothes,

The Hebrews did not shave, but they grew beards. The Egyptians were clean-shaven. (Makeover, from dungeon to palace)

**he came to Pharaoh.** Joseph's life has been one of ups and downs.

**Genesis 41:15** It happened before with the testimony of the cupbearer.

The greatest temptation of Joseph's life will be maintaining his integrity towards God in the midst of prosperity:

Genesis 41:16 To God Be The Glory: "It is not in me; God will give Pharaoh a favorable answer." What a witness for God Joseph was. Daniel follows. Daniel 2:27-28

"It is not in me; Humility in its truest sense! I can't be the person I must be, apart from God. 2 Corinthians 3:5

<u>God will give</u> – **4 times: Verses 16, 25, 28, 32.** Joseph pointed to God again and again.

**God will give Pharaoh a favorable answer."** That was a brave statement, Pharoah, who was considered a god, Joseph said, "*Elohim, Creator Sovereign,"* "*God would explain the dream to Pharoah, God is superior to you!"* What a bold witness of Faith!

**The Pharaoh** who was "regarded as a divine and son of the sun god incarnate."

To the cupbearer, Joseph boldly said, Genesis 40:8

Verses 17-24 Pharaoh Tells Joseph His Dream: Genesis 41:17-21

**Note:** it could not be detected that they had devoured them; This is an additional statement that Pharaoh adds to the story, one he did not mention at the beginning.

Genesis 41:22-24

Verses 25-36 Joseph Interprets The Dream: Genesis 41:25 <u>God has</u> <u>told</u> to Pharaoh what He is about to do. Notice the witness for God! Joseph has invoked God as the interpreter and revealer of the dreams. **Jeremiah 18:7-10** 

Genesis 41:26-28

<u>God has shown</u> to Pharaoh what He is about to do. Notice the witness for God.

**Genesis 41:29-30** Some have suggested that the Nile, which floods each year, bringing topsoil and water, would not overflow for seven years. Creating a famine. **2 Kings 8:1** 

God bless the faithful messenger who speaks the entire message of God!

Genesis 41:32 the matter is determined by God, and God will quickly bring it about. Notice the exalting of God!

This famine was to preserve Israel. To multiply Israel in a perfect environment for growth, multiplying over a million, then returning to Canaan.

"Kings do not make history but rather God uses them to effect His purposes."

### 4 Verses 33-40 Joseph Promoted

Verses 33-36 Joseph Advises Pharaoh: discerning "discreet, to show understanding, to perceive, pay attention" (We Would say, They Get It!) wise, "skilled, intelligent, ability to judge" "A person with understanding who pays attention, with intelligence, applies it to life."

Joseph, a faithful messenger, tells Pharaoh the meaning of God's message and then gives instructions on its application of this truth.

**Genesis 41:34 "Let Pharaoh take action -** When God reveals His will to us, we are expected by God to act upon it.

We are responsible for the message this morning, for what we have heard.

Genesis 41:35-36 There were thieves in Pharaoh's day, rip-offs!

Genesis 41:37-38 "Can we find a man like this, in whom is a divine spirit?" "In whom is the spirit of God" This is the first time in Scripture that mentions the Holy Spirit coming upon a person. Later in Exodus 31:3-5; 35:30-31, Fulfilled in Acts 2

Genesis 41:39 no one so discerning and wise as you are. Genesis 41:33

Proverbs 21:1

Genesis 41:40 "You shall be over my house,

Struck by the suddenness of the promotion of Joseph.

Psalm 105:20-22; Acts 7:9-10

"The secret of power is character, but the secret of character is God."
