Abortion Is Not A Political Issue; It Is A Biblical/Moral Issue!

Psalms 139 is one of the greatest passages in literature about the miracle of human conception and birth.

(Presenting God's View, God's Word, on the Unborn)

Psalm 139 What we think about God and our relationship with Him determines what we think about everything else that makes up our busy world—

Man's great need is "Theology"—the right knowledge of God—which is essential to a fulfilled life in this world.

Psalm 139 is a Hymn that a believer can sing about the wonders of God.

Verses 1-6 Wonder Of God's Knowledge (All-Knowing)

God knows everything about us, even knows what we will say before we say it!

Verses 7-12 Wonder Of God's Presence (Everywhere)

God is everywhere; there is no place where God is not!

Verses 13-18 Wonder Of God's Power (All-Powerful)

God's power is demonstrated (All-Knowing, Omniscient) at conception in the womb and continues to birth.

Verses 19-24 Wonder Of God's Judgment (Ultimate Judge)

God's righteous Judgement comes in God's time and way.

Thought Of Our Passage: "Psalmist Is In Wonder Of God's Power To Form Uniquely Every Person, And Knowing Before Birth Their Number Of Days."

1. Verses 13-16 God Created Me:

Psalm 139:13

God led David to describe God's greatest power through the miracle of birth. Genesis 1:27 "Created" is used three times

For You formed my inward parts;

Literally, "*created*." *Arranged our genetic structure, our vital organs.* A child is a work of God. God is the one that forms.

You wove (covered) me in my mother's womb.

Means "woven together, shaped us, knits us"; the "idea of God putting the body parts together"

Nine months in which God, as an artisan, would weave a tapestry in the mother's womb.

Isaiah - Isaiah 49:5

Jeremiah - Jeremiah 1:5

Apostle Paul - Galatians 1:15

Psalm 139:14 I will give thanks to You,

These truths: a child is a work of God; the organs, the structure; God shaped us and protects us. We should be thankful to God.

for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; (*Tremble in wonder*)

**Psalm 139:14 Wonderful are Your works, And my soul knows it very well.
Psalm 8:3-4**

**"Wonder and Worship Go Together" Helps us put daily life together.
(Life is beyond us; we must rest in faith in God)**

Psalm 139:15 My frame was not hidden from You,

Term **frame** is "*the skeleton, the bony framework of the child*"

When I was made in secret,

skillfully wrought

"*Intricately formed*" is translated as "*embroidered*."

The veins, arteries, muscles, and tendons.

Note: Abortion interrupts this miracle. What a tragedy!

Psalm 139:16 (NLT) You saw me before I was born.

Every day of my life was recorded in your book.

Every moment was laid out before a single day had passed.

Your eyes have seen my unformed substance;

"*Unformed mass folded together*" or "*intricately made with great care*" describes the embryo rolled up like an egg, a ball.

God has made us as we are; we must accept ourselves, and we must be ourselves.

Parable of the Pounds Luke 19:11–27;

Parable of the Talents Matthew 25:14-30

Ephesians 2:10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus

"And in Your book were all written

The days that were ordained for me," Job 14:5

6th Commandment (Life) Exodus 20:13 "You shall not murder.

This Commandment is made up of two Hebrew words.

It bluntly says, *"No killing, No murder"*

This Commandment speaks of the sanctity of life, the precious gift from God!

Murder says, *"I don't believe life is important. It is not sacred (Image of God); I have authority to take it!"*

Implications:

Abortions, Suicide, and Mercy Killing are all forms of murder. Life comes from God;

2. Verses 17-18 God Considers Me:

Psalm 139:17

Literally *"How precious also are Your thoughts concerning me"*

When we sleep, God thinks about us; when we don't think of Him, He is thinking of us!

Jeremiah 29:11 God's thoughts and plans for us go "From The Womb To The Tomb And Beyond"

Psalm 139:18 If I should count them, they would outnumber the sand.

Complexity of body

God created these bodies and, in so doing, also sustains these bodies.

When I awake, I am still with You.

While we sleep God is keeping these bodies.

God Is The God Of Forgiveness: Psalm 130:3-4

~ 1 in 4 women will have an abortion in their lifetime.

~ 54% of those who have abortions identify as "Christians."

Application:

1. God Is Our Creator. As Our Creator, We Have A Responsibility To Yield Ourselves To Him Daily. Even In Those Things That We Don't Agree Or Understand, We Must Still Yield.
2. To Maintain A Holy Wonder Of God, Found In His Word: **Psalm 40:5**
3. God Thinks Of Us! Should We Not Think About Him? **Psalm 139:17-18**
4. Speak Up For Those Who Cannot Speak: **(NLT) Proverbs 31:8 Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves; ensure justice for those being crushed.**
