1 Samuel 19:1-10

We have the battle of the wills in this chapter! Psalm 2:1-2

It is clear that every human who is not aligned with Jesus Christ being Lord of all is in conflict with the will of God!

- 1 Samuel 16-17 Saul Loved David
- 1 Samuel 18-20 Saul Envies David

We will look at 3 areas in our study:

- 1. Verses 1-7 Jonathan's Love For David
- 2. Verses 8-17 Saul's Hatred For David
- 3. Verses 18-24 God's Protection Of David

1. Verses 1-7 – Jonathan's Love For David:

- 1 Samuel 19:1
- "Now" 1 Samuel 18:28-30
- 1 Samuel 18:8 "Now what more can he have but the kingdom?"
- 1 Samuel 18:10-13
 - 1. Acts 7:1-2 Saul breathing threats & murders.
 - 2. Acts 23:12-22 Plot to kill Paul; Son of Paul's sister overhears it.
 - 3. Dan. 6:6-24 Plot to kill Daniel.
 - 4. Esther 7:1-10 Haman plots to kill Jews & Mordacai; Then hangs on his own gallows.
 - 5. Gen. 27:41-42 Esau plots to kill Jacob Rebekah hears it.

Need to trust God.... But let us never tempt God – Matthew 4:5-7

Paul Warning The Ephesian Elders: Acts 20:27-32

1 Samuel 19:3-4

Jonathan Rebukes His Father: "Do not let the king sin against his servant David, since he has not sinned against you,"

1 Samuel 19:5

Note that Jonathan called Saul's action "Sin"; we have managed to call everything but sin.

2. Verses 8-17 - Saul's Hatred For David:

1 Samuel 19:8

When envy and jealousy has not been confessed and repented of, it will rear its ugly head.

Verses 9-10 – Saul's Rage: 1 Samuel 19:9

Romans 1:18-32

1 Samuel 19:10

"tried to pin David to the wall" - This is the 2nd attempt - 1 Samuel 18:11

What was going on in David's heart? Psalm 59:1-17 is the commentary on 1 Samuel 19:11-17.

- Psalm 59:1-8 Clouds Gather Storm Prayed Checked Heart
- Psalm 59:9-15 Growing Confidence Fighting the Lord (sin)
- Psalm 59:16-17 Conviction & Praise Past & Present

Verses 11-17 – David Rescued By Saul's Daughter: 1 Samuel 19:11

Saul's Daughter/David's Wife Protects David.

"David fled and escaped and came to Samuel at Ramah," – (Distance from Gibeah to Ramah about 2 miles).

"stayed in Naioth" – "clusters of booths" – a community of Ramah.

Verse 20 – 1st Group Prophesied: 1 Samuel 19:20

Verse 21 – 2nd & 3rd Group Prophesied: 1 Samuel 19:21-24

Application:

- 1. It Is Clear That Every Human Who Is Not Aligned With Jesus Christ Being Lord Of All Is In Conflict With The Will Of God.
- 2. Jonathan Made A Covenant With David And The Loyalty To That Covenant Was Tested And Jonathan Proved Himself Faithful.
- 3. Saul Teaches Us That When Envy And Jealousy Has Not Been Confessed And Repented Of, It Will Yet again Rear Its Ugly Head.
- 4. Jonathan Called His Father Saul's Action's "Sin". As Followers Of God, We Need To Use The Same Terms And Definitions That God Uses.
