1. Verses 1-5 - David's Flight To Moab:

- 1 Samuel 22:1
- "So David departed from there" 1 Samuel 21:10
- 1 Samuel 21:12-15
- "and escaped to the cave of Adullam;" 10 miles South of Gath, 15 miles from Bethlehem.

David, in a cave, compiled Psalm 57, 142.

- 1 Samuel 22:2
- "distressed" those in fear confusion, hassled by the world, flesh, devil.
- "debt" bankrupt beggarly poor have nothing are in great need.
- "discontented" bitter of soul, disappointed, frustrated.
- "gathered to him;" We come to Jesus: distressed, in debt, discontented.
- 1 Chron. 12:8 Some of his mighty men and their leaders are listed in 2 Sam. 23:8-39 and 1 Chron. 11:10-41.

1 Samuel 22:3

"Mizpah" – "watchtower or watchman"; Probably a fortress in Moab.

"Moab;" – Moabites were not a people favored by the Jews, Deuteronomy 23:3-6; 1 Samuel 14:47.

David had family ties; this is the homeland of David's great grandmother Ruth who was a Moabite. Ruth 1:4-18; 4:21-22

Psalm 57:1-2

1 Samuel 22:4

"stronghold." – Mesudah – may refer to Masada towering 1,320 feet above the Dead Sea. 35 miles Southwest of Adullam. Psalm's 18:2; 62:2

1 Samuel 22:5

"The prophet Gad said to David," – 2 Sam. 24:11-19; 1 Chron. 21:9-19; 2 Chron. 29:25;1 Chron. 29:29.

"forest of Hereth." – A few miles southeast of Adullam.

2. Verses 6-23 - Saul Murders The Priests:

1 Samuel 22:6

1 Samuel 14:2 – "Gibeah, under the pomegranate tree"

1 Samuel 22:7

David attracted men who were willing to risk their lives for him, but Saul had to use bribery and fear to keep his forces together.

1 Samuel 22:8

Saul Charges His Captains With Disloyalty.

Saul Charges His Son Jonathan With Treason: "my son makes a covenant with the son of Jesse,"

1 Samuel 18:1-4 – Covenant Of David And Jonathan Established.

1 Samuel 20:14-17 – Covenant Of David And Jonathan Extending To Saul's Family.

Saul Charges David With Conspiracy: "my servant against me to lie in ambush, as it is this day."

1 Samuel 22:9

"Doeg the Edomite," – the name Doeg – "anxiety, or concern"; Edomite – this man was a descendent of Esau, Jacob's brother.

1 Samuel 21:7

Verses 11-15 – The Priests Trial: 1 Samuel 22:11-12

"Saul said, 'Listen now, son of Ahitub.'" Saul did not call him by his name Ahimelech – "brother of the king".

"And he answered, 'Here I am, my lord.'" Notice the respect for Saul by Ahimelech; Does not drop to Saul's level.

1 Samuel 22:13

Saul levels 4 charges against Ahimelech:

- 1. "you have given him bread"
- 2. "and a sword"
- 3. "and have inquired of God for him,"
- **4.** "so that he would rise up against me by lying in ambush as it is this day?"
- 1 Samuel 22:14 The same argument Jonathan had previously used 1 Samuel 19:4-5.
- 1 Samuel 22:15

Verses 16-19 – The Unjust Sentence: 1 Samuel 22:16 (Deut. 24:16)

1 Samuel 22:17

1 Samuel 14:45 – soldiers refused to kill Jonathan.

1 Samuel 22:18-19

1 Samuel 15:9

Partial fulfillment of the prophecy on Eli's house; Abimelech's great grandfather Phinehas. (1 Samuel 2:27-36; 4:10-18), for God promised to replace the house of Eli with the house of Zadok (1 Kings 2:26-27; 4:2).

Verses 20-23 – God Protects The Priest: 1 Samuel 22:20

"named Abiathar," - revealed in the prophecy - 1 Samuel 2:33

"Abiathar" - "my father remains"; what irony!

1 Samuel 23:6

1 Samuel 22:21-22

Note How David Takes Responsibility; The Opposite Of Saul.

1 Samuel 22:23

Application:

- 1. The People Around David Would Never Have Been Noticed In History Were It Not For Their Association With David, Just As The Disciples Of Jesus Would Have Died Unknown Had They Not Walked With Jesus.
- 2. David, Like Jesus Christ, Attracted Men Who Were Willing To Risk Their Lives For Him, But Saul (Satan) Had To Use Bribery And Fear To Keep His Forces Together.
