<u>1. Verses 1-4 – Disloyalty</u> <u>2. Verses 5-12 – Bravery</u> <u>3. Verses 13-16 – Farce</u> <u>4. Verses 17-25 – Duplicity</u>

1. Verses 1-4 – Disloyalty:

1 Samuel 26:1

1 Samuel 25:1

"Ziphites" – The inhabitants of Ziph, who 2X revealed to Saul the hiding place of David. 1 Samuel 23:19; 1 Samuel 26:1

"came to Saul at Gibeah," – (traveled 25 miles North)

Psalm 54:1-7

1 Samuel 26:2

Saul had confessed that David was righteous, 1 Samuel 24:17-22. Now Saul is in hot pursuit!

"Ziph" – About three miles southeast of Hebron, Judean hill country.

1 Samuel 26:3-4

2. Verses 5-12 – Bravery:

1 Samuel 26:5

"Abner" – "my father is Ner"; is Saul's commander. The son of Ner and uncle of Saul (being the brother of his father, Kish).

Psalm 18:17

1 Samuel 26:6

"Then David said to Ahimelech the Hittite" – Commander of David's army.

"Hittite" – broken down tribe – were mentioned in Abraham's time, Genesis 15:20.

"Abishai the son of Zeruiah, Joab's brother," – (David's nephew through David's sister) 1 Chron. 2:16; Great warrior, 2 Sam. 23:18-19.

1 Samuel 26:12 – "because a sound sleep from the LORD had fallen on them."

1 Samuel 26:7

"his spear" - "symbol of Saul's authority and office."

1 Samuel 26:8

1 Samuel 24 – Now God is giving another chance!

David had learned from 1 Samuel 25 not to avenge himself!

Danger of basing God's will on circumstances and neglecting the Word of God. (Saul was anointed by God)

David rebukes Saul – 1 Samuel 24:8-15; 1 Samuel 26:14-25

"a sound sleep from the LORD had fallen on them." - Genesis 2:21

3. Verses 13-16 – Farce:

1 Samuel 26:13-14

Verses 15-16 – David Rebukes Abner

Example in the NT under Roman guard: Acts 16:27

4. Verses 17-25 – Duplicity:

1 Samuel 26:17

"David said, 'It is my voice, my lord the king.'" – Saul's daughter Michal was no longer David's wife, 1 Samuel 25:44, so David was no longer son-in-law.

1 Samuel 26:18

"Or what evil is in my hand?" – Only thing evil in David's hand was Saul's spear!

1 Samuel 26:19

Romans 12:17-19

1 Samuel 26:20-21

"Then Saul said, 'I have sinned.'" <u>This is confession</u>, to agree with God – The next step is <u>repentance</u> – turning from the sin. It is a U-turn. <u>Faith</u> <u>towards God</u> – to place our faith and trust in God.

Confession of sin, repentance, and faith towards God; All we can go by is the fruit of repentance, Matthew 3:7-9.

Saul is getting sentimental again, 1 Samuel 24:17.

"I have played the fool" – "to do foolish things, to be silly"; to rebel against God and think we will get away with it, or when one sins and thinks he can get away with it!

Last Word's Of David To Saul: "so may my life be highly valued in the sight of the LORD, and may He deliver me from all distress."

1 Samuel 26:25

Last Word's Of Saul To David: "Then Saul said to David, "Blessed are you, my son David;"
