1 Samuel 3:1-15

The Book of 1 Samuel is a crucial link from the forbidding days of Judges to David's monarchy.

Samuel – "The name of God" "Heard of God" and "Asked of God"

Abraham was the first prophet; Gen 20:7 "He is a prophet"; Moses the great prophet – Deut 18:15, 18-22; 34:10; Samuel became a first in a series of prophets.

1 Samuel 1-7 – The Ministry Of Samuel: There are 3 main characters in the book: Samuel, Saul, and David.

<u>1. Verses 1-9 – Call Of A Prophet</u> <u>2. Verses 10-18 – Message Of A Prophet</u> <u>3. Verses 19-21 – Ministry Of A Prophet</u>

## 1. Verses 1-9 – Call Of A Prophet:

1 Samuel 3:1

"boy" – "young person"; now in his teens –Term boy was used of David when he took on Goliath – 1 Sam 17:33

1 Sam. 2:12 – Worthless sons – Hophni & Phinehas:

- 1. Worthless reprobate v. 12
- 2. Corrupted sacrifices v. 13-17
- 3. Fornication v. 22
- 4. Eli tolerant of sin v. 24

## Samuel was ministering to the Lord! (submission)

# The spiritual leaders were corrupt, and God's people weren't obeying His law, so <u>Why should God say anything new to them</u>?

A Famine For The Word: Amos 8:11-12

1 Sam 3:2-3

"lamp of God had not yet gone out" – Lampstand or Candlestick – 7 lamps of Tabernacle – Ex. 27:20-21; Ex. 30:8; Lev. 24:2

# The lamp was a symbol of the light of God's truth given to the world through His people Israel.

1 Sam 3:4 – "that the LORD called Samuel;" – The Lord spoke to Samuel 4X (1 Sam. 3:4, 6, 8, 10)

1 Sam 3:5

# One of the marks of a faithful servant is an attentive ear and an immediate willing response.

1 Sam 3:6-9

Be Still: "And Eli said to Samuel, 'Go lie down,'"

Be Attentive: "and it shall be if He calls you, that you shall say, 'Speak, LORD, for Thy servant is listening.'"; "to hear so as to obey".

#### 2. Verses 10-18 – Message Of A Prophet:

1 Sam 3:10

God Of Grace Reaching Out: "and called as at other times,"

Obedient Servant Responding: And Samuel said, "Speak, for Thy servant is listening." The word listening – "to hear with interest, to obey"

1 Sam 3:11-12

1 Sam. 2:27-36 – Is God merciful – 8-10 years have gone by

1 Sam. 4:11,18 – Another 15 years; Total 25 years

Rev. 3:7 – "He Who is holy, Who is true," – Holy – hates sin... pure, True – implements Justice – wrath.

1 Sam 3:13

Eli Was Warned About God's Judgment: "For I have told him that I am about to judge his house forever for the iniquity"

Eli Knew God's Judgment Was Coming: "which he knew,"

Eli's Son's Brought The Judgment On Themselves: "because his sons brought a curse on themselves"

Eli Was Partly Responsible For God's Judgment: "and he did not rebuke them."

1 Sam 3:14

# Eli's family sins were deliberate and defiant, and for such sins no sacrifice could be offered!

Numbers 15:30-31

1 John 5:16

Eli and his sons were hardened – Gen. 6:3, Noah's day, God was patient for 120 years

1 Sam 3:15

Nehemiah – (Neh. 2:1-8) Before King of Babylon Nathan – (2 Sam. 12:1-14) "David, you are the man" Moses – (Exodus) Pharaoh – "Let my people go" Elijah – 450 prophets Joshua – "as for me and my house"

Greatest Example Of Jesus Christ: 1 Tim 6:13-14

God gives us the Message (Bible), we must share it. Eph. 4:15 – Love & Truth

1 Sam 3:16-18

The Greatest Test Of God's Prophet: Will He Speak God's Message Without Compromise? Not Adding, Not Subtracting? "Samuel told him – <u>everything; hid nothing from him</u>."

Galatians 4:16

And he said, "It is the LORD; let Him do what seems good to Him." Eli exhibits passive resignation to something that I believe he could have changed!

## 3. Verses 19-21 – Ministry Of A Prophet:

1 Sam 3:19

"Thus Samuel grew" – 1 Samuel 2:21

"let none of his words fail." - "to fall to the ground"

Eccl. 12:11

1 Sam 3:20

"Israel from Dan even to Beersheba" – North to South 150 miles; all of Israel heard about Samuel.

# God used this difficult task to confirm to others that Samuel was God's man; That he was speaking on behalf of God.

1 Sam 3:21

## **Conclusion**:

- 1. Israel's Lack Of Spirituality Restrained God From Speaking And Giving Direction. It Was Not God's Fault But The People's. When We Don't Hear God Speaking, We Should Do Spiritual Inventory.
- 2. Samuel Models The Mark Of A Faithful Servant Of God; One Who Has An Attentive Ear And An Immediate And Willing Heart Of Response.
- 3. The Greatest Test Of God's Prophet: Will He Speak God's Message Without Compromise? Not Adding, Not Subtracting?
