Series "Knowing The Exact Truth" "The Consolation of Israel" Luke 2:21-40 Study-7

Luke 2:25 The word **consolation** - Greek word *paraklesis*, is used to describe the Holy Spirit "*The Comforter"* in **John 14:16** - The term "*The Consolation of Israel"* is a name for the Messiah used commonly among the Jews, **Isaiah 12:1**; **49:13**

The consolation Jesus brought was better than any political freedom: **Jesus gave spiritual freedom and forgiveness of sin.**

Luke records the 8 days after birth then 40 days after birth.

Simeon and Anna are matched characters: Both were probably old **Luke 2:2:26-29, 36-37** both <u>devout</u>, both expected the <u>consolation</u> and the <u>redemption</u>, <u>both were prophets</u>.

Luke's Purpose: "Knowing The Exact Truth About Jesus Christ" Luke 1:4

Thought Of Our Passage: "All Who Trust In Jesus, Know That Jesus Is Truly The Consolation Of Israel And The Consolation Of All Who Believe."

- 1. Verses 21-24 Jesus And Moses
- 2. Verses 25-35 Jesus And Simeon
- 3. Verses 36-40 Jesus And Anna

1. Verses 21-24 Jesus And Moses

Luke 2:21 And when eight days had passed,

Context - This is 8 days after Jesus' birth Luke 2:1-20.

Mary and Joseph obeyed the Law by having Jesus circumcised 8 days later.

Circumcision - Started with Abraham in Genesis 17:12

It was a sign that Abraham was in a covenant relationship with God. (Outward sign of the new birth of God's righteousness by faith)

Romans 4:11 John the Baptist was circumcised Luke 1:59

Jesus, "Jehovah is salvation" - His name speaks of Jesus' mission to save. **Philippians 2:9**

the name given by the angel before He was conceived in the womb. (Gabriel said to Joseph Matthew 1:21) Gabriel said to Mary (Luke 1:31) from His Father.

Luke 2:22 And when the days for their purification

This was 40 days after birth. A birth brought defilement. (Jesus is identifying with a sinful world) (Leviticus 12:2-8)

according to the law of Moses Notice the word **law –** used **5 times** in these verses.

Galatians 4:4-5

Luke 2:23 That every first-born son was to be redeemed. (Exodus 13:2; Numbers 3:13, 18:15)

Luke 2:24 The Truth - Only God Can Redeem Us:

It was God who delivered Israel when the angel of death passed over. It was not their cleverness!

"A PAIR OF TURTLEDOVES, OR TWO YOUNG PIGEONS."

Leviticus 12:8 states that if one cannot afford a lamb, they can substitute with doves or pigeons.

Our sufficiency Is In Jesus Christ. 2 Corinthians 3:5

2. Verses 25-35 Jesus And Simeon

Luke 2:25 Simeon - root; "to hear intelligently, to give attention, obedience to, perceive"

Simeon – Was what the nation of Israel should have been, looking for consolation:

and this man was righteous righteousness that can only come through faith.

and devout, This speaks of the works with a right heart that followed his faith in God.

consolation - is a name for the Messiah. The God of Comfort who came to give spiritual freedom and forgiveness of sin.

and the Holy Spirit was upon him. Uncommon experience (Select Few) prior to Pentecost and the Holy Spirit being poured out.

Luke 2:26 revealed to him by the Holy Spirit - The Holy Spirit is the source of revelation and testimony. (Holy Spirit Illuminates God's Word, When Bible Speaks, God Speaks!)

Luke 2:27 And he came in the Spirit into the temple;

A special sensitivity in that the Holy Spirit directed Simeon to enter the temple he had a desire; a thought.

to carry out for Him the custom of the Law,

(Offered 5 shekels for the child, then the child receives a blessing/prayer)

Luke 2:28 then he took Him into his arms, and blessed God, and said, Simeon was holding in his arms the Son of God.

Verses 29-32 Simeon's Song (5th Song):

Luke 2:29 According to Your word; What word was that? Luke 2:26

"Now Lord, You are releasing "the freeing of a slave from keeping watch" Your bond-servant to depart in peace,

We are never ready to die until we have seen Jesus!

According to Your word; KJV Psalms 138:2 for thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name.

Luke 2:30 For my eyes have seen Your salvation, (That's The Person Jesus)
John 14:6 This is a person!

How do we see Jesus today? Ephesians 1:23

Luke 2:31 Which You have prepared in the <u>presence of all peoples</u>, This birth of Jesus was foretold by the prophets and the religious leaders knew that it was so.

Luke 2:32 A LIGHT OF REVELATION (The Truth Leading To God) **TO THE GENTILES,** Salvation was not exclusively for Israel but it was for all the nations.

And the glory of Your people Israel."

Jesus is the fulfillment of the covenant promises

Luke 2:33 His father and mother were amazed – (Amazed 13 times in Luke) "to wonder, and marvel at"

Context "light of revelation to the gentiles"

Verses 34-35 The Mission Of Jesus: Luke 2:34 And Simeon blessed them, He pronounced a blessing from God upon them.

the fall and rise of many in Israel, Isaiah 8:14; 1 Corinthians 1:23; 1 Peter 2:6-8

appointed for the fall (Negative)

It was foretold that Jesus was to be rejected **Isaiah 8:14**

and rise of many in Israel, (Positive)

Believing resulting in resurrection to life eternal.

and for a sign to (Point to God) be opposed— (Negative)

Those who would oppose God and reject His message and offer of salvation through faith.

John 7:5 For not even His brothers were believing in Him.

Luke 2:35 and a sword (Large Sword) **will pierce even your own soul—** Mary would stand at the foot of the cross and there see her son hanging there.

to the end that thoughts from many hearts may be revealed." Jesus was God in the flesh. He knew what was in the heart of man.

God's Word exposes us and reveals what is really there. Hebrews 4:12

John 2:24-25 Jesus knew the religious.

Luke 6:8 But He knew what they were thinking,

"Jesus is not only a revelation; in revealing God, He also reveals us"

Simeon is a faithful servant of God that held on in hope!

3. Verses 36-40 Jesus And Anna

Luke 2:36 And there was a prophetess, OT was "fore-telling" then in the NT it came to be more "forth-telling" It came to mean the forth-telling of God's Word, His message.

Prophetess - The term is used 8 times.

This does not mean that women were pastors.

Anna the daughter of Phanuel, "the face of God" of the tribe of Asher (One of The Lost 10 Tribes)

seven years after her marriage,

married a relatively short time of 7 years.

Luke 2:37 (NIV) 37 and then was a widow until she was eighty-four. Married when she was a teen, Anna could have been 105 years.

How Anna Spent Her Time: She never left the temple, serving night and day with fastings and prayers.

This is a model for devotion to the Lord. 1 Timothy 5:9-10

Anna – Teaches us that a life given to God is to be a life of consistency. That no matter how old we are we can serve God.

Luke 2:38 Jesus' Mission Was To Redeem: and continued to speak of Him - Anna continued her forth-telling.

Luke 2:39-40

Doctor Luke's Evaluation Of Jesus: The Child continued to grow and become strong, - Jesus continued to grow physically.

increasing in wisdom; Jesus continued to grow intellectually.

and the grace of God was upon Him. Jesus continued to grow spiritually.

Application:

- 1. No Matter What My Age Is, God Has A Place That I Can Serve Him In.
- 2. The Only Title That Matters Is That Of Being A Faithful Servant Of God.
- 3. Anna's Witness Of Consistent Obedience Resulted In Fruitfulness.
- 4. Salvation Is A Person Called The Way, The Truth And The Life, Jesus.
