"The God Of The Living" Matthew 22:23-33

Job asks this question: Job 14:14 "If a man dies, will he live again?

We have but 2 Sources for the answers - Human Speculation: or Divine Revelation: Word of God. John 17:17

Resurrection – "act of rising from the dead, to rise again, to live again"

Jesus raised 3 people from the dead during His 3 years of ministry:

A Widow's Son - Luke 7:14-15
 The Daughter of Jairus - Luke 8:54-55
 Lazarus - John 11:43-44

Thought Of Our Passage: "Rejection Of The Resurrection Only Proves That One Does Not Understand The Scriptures Nor The Power Of God"

1. Verses 23-28 Resurrection & Human Speculation:

Matthew 22:23 On that day the day was Tuesday of the Passion Week. Tuesday is referred to as "The Day of Controversy" It is a day that Jesus is confronted by the religious leaders with 5 questions.

The Context was a political/religious question "Is it lawful for us to pay taxes to Caesar, or not?"

This morning's next question deals with the "Life After Death"

The error of thinking that the eternal order is like the earthly!

Sadducees –They were overseers of the temple in the first century.

Sadducees prized themselves as being the priests! Deuteronomy 7:6-8

5 False Beliefs Of The Sadducees That Led To Bad Behavior:

1. Sadducees Did Not Believe In The Resurrection: (who say there is no resurrection) Sadducees claimed it was not in God's Word. They only recognized The Pentateuch as Scripture.

The Bible records no less than 10 accounts of people being raised from the dead in both the OT & NT.

- 2. Sadducees Did Not Believe In A Future Judgment: Genesis 3:4

 The first doctrine doubted and denied by the Devil is that of the judgment of God!
- 3. Belief That The Soul Perishes Along With The Body: (Annihilation) This is a popular belief today with the cults.
- 4. Sadducees Did Not Believe In Angels Or Demons: Acts 23:8
- **5. Sadducees Did Not Believe In Miracles:** They were the equivalent to what we know of today as rationalists –

came to Jesus and questioned Him, not coming in sincerity but in trickery.

Matthew 22:24 asking, "Teacher, Moses said,

Sadducees are referring to **Deuteronomy 25:5-10** "Levirate Marriage." (The word levirate comes form the Latin word levir which means "a husband's brother") This was God's plan which a family line could be preserved, the property would remain in the family. **Genesis 38:6-18; Ruth 4:1-13**

In the time of Jesus it was no longer practiced so it was just some jibberjabber talk.

Matthew 22:25-27 Possibly borrowed from the apocryphal book "Tobit"

Matthew 22:28 resurrection, whose wife of the seven will she be? For they all had married her." They thought that after death all would continue as before, thus making this woman and men guilty of incest.

2. Verses 29-33 Resurrection & Divine Revelation:

Matthew 22:29 "You are mistaken - Latin (err) literally means "to wander astray" (our word planet, wandering stars, Jude 1:13)

- 2 Point Description of Liberal Theology.
- 1. Not A Clear Understanding Of The Scriptures (The truth of Scripture) not understanding the Scriptures,

The Sadducees' problem was not with the doctrine of the resurrection (They Thought) but the real problem was their ignorance of Scripture!

2. Not A Clear Understanding Of God's Power - (God's nature) nor the power of God.

Notice that **knowing comes before the power** of God! They did not know Him!

Philippians 3:20-21; Romans 1:4; Luke 20:34

Worldly Thinking - The afterlife is not the same order as the present life: "The sons of this age This is the God given pattern until we leave and go to heaven.

Notice what Jesus said, "The sons of this age marry and are given in marriage, Jesus was affirming that Marriage is proper.

God, Marriage, Then Procreation We need to invest in marriage and our families but God has to be first!

Matthew 22:30 "For in the resurrection they neither marry, nor are given in marriage; When a person dies, they will enter a different state.

The error of thinking of heaven in terms of earth and of thinking of eternity in terms of time.

but are like angels in heaven. (comparison) He wasn't saying that we become angels – but that like the angels in heaven, there is no need for propagation in heaven as there is on earth, to continue to replace humans that die.

1 Corinthians 15:43

We pray to do God's will on earth as it is in heaven. There, it will be God's will. (Not Making Heaven Like Earth)

Romans 6:5

Matthew 22:31 "But regarding the resurrection of the dead, Jesus now confronts their disbelief in the resurrection.

have you not read what was spoken to you by God: Jesus now asks them, don't you read the Scriptures?

You claim the Books of Moses, but have you read them?

which was spoken to you by God note that the OT Law was God's spoken Word to us! Mark 12:26 "But regarding the fact that the dead rise again,

Matthew 22:32

Matthew 22:24 saying, "Teacher, Moses said, He knew that Moses was the only authority they would accept.

Exodus 3:6

This passage teaches 2 great truths regarding life after death:

1. When We Die We Don't Leave Our Relationship With God. Our Relationship With God Deepens.

God is present tense. He did not say, "I was the God of Abraham," for that would mean that Abraham was no more.

2. After Death We Retain Our Personal Identity Just Like Abraham, Isaac, Jacob.

The God of - Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob are all alive with the Lord. "The Living God Must Be The God Of Living Men" He is not the God of the dead but of the living."

Matthew 22:33-34 He had put the Sadducees to Silence – literally "muzzled"

Application:

- **1. Do I Have A Believing Mind?** A mind that accepts Jesus and His Word as the final authority, rejecting human speculation.
- **2. Do I Believe And Trust In The Power Of God?** A genuine faith that trusts in God who can do the miraculous which results in a life worth living.
- **3. Do I Have The Certainty And Hope Of The Resurrection?** That this present life is but a proving ground for the next.
