- 1. But we have renounced the things hidden because of shame, "to be ashamed, to handle with unclean hands." We can speak the truth but be living a lie!
- 2. Not walking in craftiness "The fisherman that uses bait to lure away a fish, to do whatever one please to achieve a certain goal." "The End Justifies The Means!"
- 3. Or adulterating the word of God, the word adulterating "deceiving, to make corrupt." Lies, half-truths, mixture, little truth with a big lie!
