3 Reasons For Making David King:

Reason 1 – You Are Our Flesh And Blood: "and said, 'Behold, we are your bone and your flesh.'" Genesis 2:23

2 Samuel 5:2

Reason 2 – You Have Proven Yourself Under Saul: "you were the one who led Israel out and in." Good military leader!

Reason 3 – The Lord Said You Would Be Leader: "the LORD said to you, 'You will shepherd My people Israel, and you will be a ruler over Israel.'"

Unlike Saul, who was a Benjamite, David was from the royal tribe of Judah, Genesis 49:10.

2 Samuel 5:3

"They Anointed" – 3X: by Samuel ,1 Samuel 16:13; Anointed, 2 Samuel 2:4, over Judah; over all of Israel, 2 Samuel 5:3.

1 Chronicles 12:23-40

The foundation of the Jewish nation was God's covenant; Deuteronomy 27-30 and Leviticus 26.

By this victory Israel regained the territory that Saul lost in his last battle.

2 Samuel 8:1; 1 Chronicles 18:1 – In subsequent campaigns, David also took back the cities the Philistines had taken from Saul.

Application:

- 1. When Making Decisions, God's Will Should Be Everything. Everything Else Is Secondary.
- 2. The City Of Jerusalem Was Chosen By God To Be His City, The City In Which Jesus Would Die, Be Buried, Raised From The Dead, Ascend To Heaven, In Which Jesus Would Also Return To And Set Up His Kingdom.
- 3. David's Greatness Was All Due To God 2 Samuel 5:10 <u>David became</u> greater and greater, for the <u>LORD God of hosts was with him</u>.
- 4. Through David's Trust And Obedience To God, Israel Experienced Victories. Israel Regained The Territory That Saul Had Lost In His Previous Battles.
