**The Thought Of Our Passage:** "Jesus Is Our Passover Lamb Who Was Once And For All Sacrificed For The Sins Of The World"

# 1. Verses 7-13 Preparation:

Luke 22:7 Then Context – Luke left off with Tuesday of the Passion Week the betrayal of Judas Luke 22:6 (Wednesday nothing recorded) Now Thursday of the Passion Week - Peter and John sent to make preparation for Passover meal, after sunset Jesus eats the meal with the twelve; washes the disciple's feet; Judas departs, Lord's Supper instituted, Garden of Gethsemane, Betrayal, Arrest, Sanhedrin, Peter's denial.

**came the first day of Unleavened Bread** Feast was lumped into Passover and lasted seven days.

on which the Passover lamb had to be sacrificed. This took place between 3:00 and 5:00 PM. At 6:00 PM started the new day. Exodus 12:3-13

**Passover lamb had to be sacrificed** (His death on the cross was the exact time the lambs were slaughtered!) lamb had to be examined for four days so Jesus was **John 1:29** 

**Luke 22:8** (Only Luke identifies Peter & John) had Judas known the location Jesus' arrest would have happened at the last supper. No, Lord's Supper, no **John 13-17** 

**Luke 22:9** The disciples were from Galilee and Jerusalem was not their home.

**Mysterious Directions: Luke 22:10 a man will meet you carrying a pitcher of water; follow him** This culture men did not carry water pitcher.

Jesus knew where this man was (in the village) -Jesus knew what he was doing (carrying a pitcher of water) -Jesus knew where he was going (follow him) -

Luke 22:11 'The Teacher says to you, "The Rabbis says" this homeowner was a disciple of the teacher.

"Where is the guest room in which I may eat the Passover with My disciples?"

What a great thing to realize that all that we have belongs to Jesus Christ.

Luke 22:12 "And he will show you a large, furnished, upper room; Homes in first century had large rooms built on top of their homes. They had an outside stairway **furnished**, "*spread"* couches

**prepare it there.**" God had prepared this man's heart who had prepared for this room.

Disciples still had human responsibility.

Luke 22:13 And they left and found everything just as He had told them; We are not to fear preparations when God is leading us.

**and they prepared the Passover.** God uses common things like willing people, rooms, bread, cups, wine to accomplish His purposes.

**Why all this preparation and secrecy?** Judas was looking for an opportunity to betray Jesus, so Jesus saw to it that this most important time was not interrupted by His arrest. This Passover was the fulfillment of 3000 Passovers.

# 2. Verses 14-18 Revelation:

Luke 22:14 When the hour had come, Jesus was in complete control.

**He reclined at the table,** They sat on these low couches and leaned on their left elbow then ate with their right hand.

- 1. Unleavened bread be ready, lack of corruption.
- 2. Bitter herbs spoke of their bitter oppression.
- 3. Salt water spoke of the bitterness of slavery with tears.
- *4. Stewed fruit -* color and consistency spoke of the mortar that they used in slavery.

- 5. The roasted lamb was to have no broken bones offered whole This spoke of the blood, the lamb of God. (Jesus was the lamb)
- 6. There were 4 cups of wine wine mixed with water that were to be drank at certain stages of the meal. To remind them of four promises that God had made. **Exodus 6:6,7**

They would read Psalms and comment about what each of these would symbolize.

and the apostles with Him. The disciples are called apostles. "One sent"

Luke 22:15 These words are so amazing as Jesus faces the cross, He is thinking about spending time with those that He loves. **Hebrews 12:2** 

# Luke 22:16 it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God." "The Marriage Supper of The Lamb" Revelation 19:6-9; Psalms 27:13

Luke 22:17 And when He had taken a cup and <u>given thanks</u>, Jesus is preparing to go to the cross and suffer as no man has ever suffered. Job 1:21; Job 2:9-10

He said, "Take this and share it among yourselves; Christianity is shared. It is not only personal, but it is a sharing of one another. (Passover Was Celebrated With Families, A New Family of God)

**Luke 22:18** This again will be the marriage supper of the lamb.

# 3. Verses 19-20 Institution:

Luke 22:19 And when He had taken some bread This bread was unleavened bread.

and given thanks, "Eucharist" comes from a Greek word that means "To give thanks"

He broke it, that is where the life comes in. His death means new life.

and gave it to them, saying, "This is My body This is not "Transubstantiation" that the bread and the grape juice become the flesh and blood of Jesus.

It is also not "Consubstantiation" that it is a mixer of blood flesh bread and juice.

That the bread is a symbol that represents the body of Jesus that was broken for us. Jesus was born in **Bethlehem -** "House of Bread" John 6:35 <u>"I am the bread of life;</u> which is given for you; The body of Jesus was broken for me. (Love)

# 1 Corinthians 15:3 <u>Christ died for our sins according to the</u> <u>Scriptures</u>,

**do this** Jesus is instituting the Lord's Supper to be perpetual until His return.

in remembrance of Me." Greek literal "*in order to my remembrance"* not mean to <u>merely</u> remembering past event. It is participation with a living Savior, (Reminder the solution to the worlds sin is Jesus Death) 1 Corinthians 11:24-26

Not magical but spiritual. Proclaim His death, and our oneness!

Luke 22:20 And in the same way He took the cup after they had eaten, some time has laps and now the cup.

**saying, "This cup** – represents the blood of Jesus, sacrificed upon the cross for us! **1 Corinthians 10:16** <u>Is not the cup of blessing</u>

which is poured out for you sacrificial offering for our sins, substitutionary sacrifice

Forgiveness through His blood of past sins, but also present new life in Jesus Christ! Galatians 2:20

**is the new covenant in My blood.** Covenant - is a "*Testament," a "Will"* Covenants were sealed with blood.

Jeremiah 31:31-34

The Lord's Supper Means The Law Is Now In The Heart: Jeremiah 31:33 "<u>I will put My law within them and on their heart</u>

The Lord's Supper Means Superior Relationship: Jeremiah 31:33 I will be their God, and they shall be My people.

The Lord's Supper Means Superior Knowledge: Jeremiah 31:34 for they will all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them,"

The Lord's Supper Means Superior Forgiveness: Jeremiah 31:34 "for <u>I will forgive their iniquity</u>, and their sin I will remember no more."

- 1. Believers Need Not Fear Adversity Because Jesus Faced The Cross For Us.
- 2. We Can Experience Peace Because Jesus Modeled Peace And In Jesus, We Have His Peace.
