Luke 22:14-38 Is called the "Upper Room Discourse" John's gospel John 13-17

Passage in part is **Matthew 26:21-35; Mark 14:18-31; Luke 22:21-38; John 13**

Luke 22 Covers Judas' plan to betray to Peter's denial of Jesus

1. Verses 21-23 Betraval:

Luke 22:21 "But Context - Thursday evening of the passion week, Jesus celebrated the Passover then Jesus declared a new covenant, Jesus had just shared there was going to be a change in the relationship. **Luke 22:20**

behold, the idea, "to look, to perceive" the hand of the one betraying Me is with Me on the table. There is debate over whether Judas was still present when Jesus set in "The Lord's Supper, Communion" John states, that Judas after eating the morsel of the Passover meal departed.

Matthew 26:23-24 and Mark 14:20-21 Luke appears to say that Judas was there and after communion Luke sometimes deviates from chronological John the Baptist Luke 3:19-20

Luke 22:22 Sovereignty Of God: "For indeed, the Son of Man is going as it has been determined; This speaks of God's foreknowledge and His divine will being carried out in the death of His Son. Judas did not force Jesus' hand! Acts 2:23-24

Son of Man – God's Son that came in flesh. Called the incarnation.

Human Responsibility: but woe to that man by whom He is betrayed!" This speaks of human responsibility. Judas fulfilled prophesy but responsible for his actions.

Luke 22:23 who was going to do this thing. They knew that they were capable

2. Verses 24-30 Dissension:

Luke 22:24 (Only Luke records this) Verses 24-27 Discussion Of Greatness: And there arose also a dispute "strife, quarrel, rivalry, contention, wrangling"

among them These are the <u>apostles of Jesus</u> that are having a quarrel. **Paul and Barnabas had a falling out! Acts 15:36-40**

as to which one of them was regarded to be greatest. Did this before **Luke 9:4,48** Context - Jesus has just spoken about giving His very blood for His disciples.

Luke 22:25 "The kings of the Gentiles (Heathens) lord it over them; There is this power over people is the mode of our world. 1 John 2:16

and those who have authority over them are called 'Benefactors.' Honorary title the government bestowed on princes, emperors, on gods "Your Royal" the oppressor over the oppressed.

Luke 22:26 "But it is not this way with you, this is not God's economy!

but the one who is the greatest among you must become like the youngest, in that culture the younger served the older persons.

and the leader like the servant. Service not power is the way of God! Philippians 2:3

leader like the servant. This phrase is used three times Luke 22:27

servant, one who serves – Speaks of "a table waiter, those that at the moment were serving them"

Luke 22:27 the one who reclines at the table, or the one who serves?

Is it not the one who reclines at the table? Jesus has been serving them!

But I am among you as the one who serves. Jesus appeals to them through His example **John 13:15**

Verses 28-30 Commendation/Promise: Luke 22:28 stood by Me "to remain by His side" Jesus recognize that they have stayed with Him. They were there when the religious confronted Jesus. Jesus was rejected by the crowds in **John 6**

Luke 22:29 and just as My Father Jesus' deity, God was His Father.

has granted Me a kingdom, I grant you Jesus has authority over the kingdom of God. That if He has a kingdom that makes Him a king. We being in Jesus have His kingdom. 2 Timothy 2:12

Luke 22:30 that you may eat and drink at <u>My table</u> in <u>My kingdom</u>, had been trials, but all would be overshadowed by the reality of this future kingdom. **Revelation 19**

and you will sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel. Revelation 20

Instructions: The World is Not Our Model In Serving Jesus Christ, Jesus Is

3. Verses 31-34 Failure:

Luke 22:31 "Simon, Simon, Jesus repeats Peter's name **two times** to get his attention. (Maybe Peter was the loudest) **Simon** was his earthy name, **Peter** was the name given by Jesus. Peter was a weak and would fail acting like a natural man. That's me and you!

behold, Satan adversary has demanded permission to sift you like wheat; "Satan has obtained you by asking" God allowed to tempt Peter. (Job 1-2)

sift you – Plural all were under temptation (book of Acts) **sift you like wheat;** There is the head of grain, the outside of the grain is worthless. A sieve was violently shaken and the worthless would be blown away. Satan wanted to blow their faith in the wind. **Luke 22:54-62**

Luke 22:32 Encouragement - but I have prayed for <u>you</u>, (singular - you Peter) that your faith may not fail; Jesus prayed for Peter. That Peter would not turn away from his faith in God.

and you, when once you have turned again, "retraced your steps, repented, change of heart, change in thinking" Peter would fail (deny Jesus) laps of faith, he would return. James 3:2 For we all stumble in many ways.

once you have turned again, strengthen your brothers." That God was going to use Peter yet again after his fall.

Luke 22:33 But he said to Him, "Lord, with You I am ready to go both to prison and to death!" Stronger than what we really are.

"Lord, with You I am ready to go both to prison and to death!" What we have here is <u>Peter arguing with the God and His Word</u>, 1 Corinthians 6:9-10

Luke 22:34 God Speaking Here! And He said, "I say to you, Peter,

the rooster will not crow today until you have denied three times that you know Me." prediction that Peter is going to not only fail but he was going to deny Jesus three times

Instructions: When We Fail, Jesus Has A Plan Of Restoration:

4. Verses 35-38 Dullness:

Luke 22:35 "When I sent you out without money belt and bag and sandals, reference to Jesus sending out the 12 Luke 9:1-5 then the 70 disciples Luke 10:1-24

you did not lack anything, did you?" And they said, "No, nothing." (9:3;10:4)

Luke 22:36 "But now, Things are going to change.

Luke 22:37 that this which is written must be fulfilled in Me, Isaiah 53:12

'AND HE WAS NUMBERED WITH TRANSGRESSORS'; for that which refers to Me has its fulfillment." Jesus was crucified with outlaws. Luke 23:32-33

Isaiah 53:12

Notice 3 Things about Jesus Christ:

- 1. Jesus Identified With Sinners: And was numbered with the transgressors;
- Jesus Is Our Sacrifice For Sin: Yet He Himself bore the sin of many, He not only came as a man but took and bore our sins.
 Isaiah 53:4-6; 1 Peter 2:24
- 3. Jesus Is Our Mediator With God: And interceded for the transgressors. This is why Peter had a comeback. Hebrews 7:25

Luke 22:38 "Lord, look, here are two swords." failed to see that Jesus was speaking about hostility they focused on the sword. 2 Corinthians 10:4; Ephesians 6:17

Later that evening Jesus told Peter to knock it off. Luke 22:50-51

When Jesus said, "It is enough." "Enough of this kind of talk" "Oh Please!"
