"The Wise Seek Him" Matthew 2:1-12 Christmas Eve 5:00 PM 2022

Matthew's account surrounding the birth of Jesus **Reveals the Attitudes/Response to Jesus' Birth.** Identical Attitudes/Response exist today around Christmas.

Herod - Opposed The King!

Religious Leaders & Citizens of Jerusalem - Ignored the King!

The Magi - Seek the King!

Thought Of Our Passage: "God Encourages Us to Seek Him Because Jesus Is Accessible And Will Be Found By The Wise"

- 1. Verses 1-10 The Wise Will Seek Him
- 2. Verses 11-12 The Wise Will Find Him

1. Verses 1-10 The Wise Will Seek Him:

Matthew 2:1 Now - Matthew 1 covered Jesus' <u>linage</u> (His rite to the throne) then His <u>supernatural advent</u> (born of a virgin) The King is "The King of Kings"

after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea This is all that Matthew says about the birth details. **Luke 2:1-20** gives details as to the very night!

in the days of Herod the king, Herod – reigned for 33 years, 37 BC to 4 BC.

Magi - our modern word "magistrate" is derived from the word **Magi**. These professionals were brilliant and highly educated scholars who were trained in **medicine**, **history**, **religion**, **prophecy** and **astronomy**.

from the east, (Babylon or Persia) suggested that they were "Oriental Scientists"

arrived in Jerusalem, The Magi would have swept into Jerusalem with pomp. At a minimum **full military escort along with their servants**.

Matthew 2:2 "Where is He who has been born King of the Jews? Isaiah 9:6-7, Daniel 9 They understood that the Messiah would come to save the Jews.

For we saw His star in the east, could have been the prophecy of Balaam. Numbers 24:17 or possibly a comet, possibly a super-nova.

in the east, (Babylon or Persia) that means at least over 1000 miles and have come to worship Him." These men were seeking God.

Many passages in the Bible encourage us to seek God and promise that we will find Him!

Isaiah 55:6; Jeremiah 29:13; Zephaniah 2:3; Amos 5:6; Matthew 7:7-8

God tells us to seek Him because He is accessible to us. God is not hard to find and is not hiding from us.

Matthew 2:3 he was troubled, literally "to agitate" and all Jerusalem with him. Herod was a man that would never dwell with a rival.

all Jerusalem with him. Why would Jerusalem troubled? Herod was worried because there was a rival throne.

Matthew 2:4 all the chief priests – the ruling party.

and scribes these were the experts of the Law. They were the theologians.

Matthew 2:5 They said to him, "In Bethlehem of Judea Jacob buried Rachel (Gen. 48:7) Boaz married Ruth (Ruth 1:22) The house of David (1 Sam 16:1-13)

Bethlehem - "House of bread" John 6:35 "I am the bread of life;

From Jerusalem to Bethlehem is about 5 miles South!

Matthew 2:6 700-year-old prophecy Micah 5:2

Religious leaders had the knowledge but no interest themselves.

Matthew 2:7 and determined from them the exact time the star appeared. Matthew 2:16

Matthew 2:8 that I too may come and worship Him." At Christmas Herod shows up! Talking God, quoting Scripture,

Matthew 2:9 they went their way; and the star, which they had seen in the east, went on before them as they started toward Bethlehem, they saw the star again.

until it came and stood over the place where the Child was. How does a star stand over a house? "By God!"

Matthew 2:10 God guides in His time.

2. Verses 11-12 The Wise Will Find Him:

Matthew 2:11 After coming into the <u>house</u> Notice that the family was in a house not a stable.

they saw the <u>Child</u> with Mary His mother; Note Child - "little child" 1 to 2 years of age.

and they fell to the ground and worshiped Him. Worshiped – "to fall upon the knees and touch the ground with the forehead as an expression of profound reverence"

they presented to Him gifts were symbolic, but gifts fit for a King.

Gold - Deity Of Jesus Gold most precious of metals a gift fit for a King

Frankincense - Ministry Of Jesus Used by the priest in sacrifice.

Myrrh – Humanity Of Jesus Used to embalm the dead.

These gifts were a result of Divine Revelation and great love.

Matthew 2:12 And having been warned by God in a dream not to return to Herod, Joseph had a dream by which God communicated to him, not to stay but leave.

- **2.** God Loves Us And Died So We Could Experience Forgiveness.
