The Context of This Passage: The Apostle Paul is in prison (Rome), awaiting his execution, he writes this second, final letter to young Timothy. Paul tells Timothy how to behave as a church leader. Paul <u>reflects on the mothers</u> who made an impact in Timothy's life.

1. 2 Timothy 3:15 Mother's Bible:

2 Timothy 3:15 and that from childhood the word **childhood** – "infancy, a new-born child, a babe" what this means is that Timothy was taught the Word of God from infancy.

you have known the sacred writings – "inspired by God, to be devoutly revered writings, documents"

Society says, Truth is Unknowable: Existentialism – (Truth is Relative)

Deuteronomy 6:4-6

Starts with the parents! We have to revere the Word, we need to have a <u>personal relationship with God ourselves</u>.

Deuteronomy 6:7

What should a Mother teach her children? Loving God!

Deuteronomy 6:8 Our <u>Actions</u> and our <u>Thinking</u>.

Deuteronomy 6:9 The message of the Word of God is <u>for the home</u> and <u>outside of the home</u>.

which are able to give you the wisdom – "to give understanding, the application of the truth" Street smarts, common sense that is not common.

Proverbs 3:21-26

that leads to salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. The Bible is God's wisdom that leads to salvation by Faith in Jesus.

The Bible and Jesus Go Together: That we love the Word it leads to Jesus, love Jesus it leads to the Word.

2. 2 Timothy 1:5 Mother's Faith:

2 Timothy 1:5 For I am mindful of the sincere faith within you, the term **sincere** – "unhypocritical, unmixed, without wax" Timothy It was real, without any pretense or façade.

which first dwelt in your grandmother Lois, and your mother Eunice,

Notice the spiritual chain here: Lois to Eunice to Timothy. Again, we don't read of <u>a grandfather</u> or <u>a father</u> anywhere in this equation.

and I am sure that it is in you as well. Even though Lois and Eunice were believers, Timothy needed to come to a point in which he placed his own faith in Christ.

Faith is not hereditary: it is a personal choice.

I'm convinced that a Mother like this has to be more interested in the spiritual than anything else.

While it isn't in the text, a mother who passes along a faith that is authentic is without a doubt <u>a praying woman</u>.

Psalm 127:1-5

Mothers, are you passing along a legacy of an Authentic Faith to your Children?

3. Acts 16:1-3 Mother's Service:

Acts 16:1 Paul came also to Derbe and to Lystra. Paul had visited a few years earlier on his 1st Missionary Journey, he now returns to the hometown of Timothy and there are **three things about Timothy that Paul notes:**

1. Timothy Was a Disciple of Jesus: And a disciple was there, named Timothy,

disciple - "follower of the teacher and his teaching"

the son of a <u>Jewish woman</u> who was a believer, but his <u>father</u> was a <u>Greek</u>, This is what we would call <u>an unequally yoked marriage</u>.

Acts 16:2

2. Timothy Had A Good Reputation: he was well spoken of by the brethren He had a good reputation in the local communities as a man of integrity, a man of the Word.

Acts 16:3

3. Timothy Was Willing and Available: Paul wanted this man to go with him; and he took him

We have this thinking of parishioners as consumers. (Creditors Versus Debtors)

Paul loved Timothy: He had only good things to say about him.

1 Corinthians 4:17; Philippians 2:20; 1 Timothy 1:2 To Timothy, my true child in the faith:

We Need Disciples of Jesus Christ Not Merely Good Citizens: So, they can share their faith with others. Serve as missionaries

Mother's, Don't Get Short Sighted And Miss The Big Picture As To What Is Being Accomplished On A Daily Basis.

Application:

Six Parenting Guidelines That Helped Susannah Wesley As A Mother:

- 1. Subdue Self-will In A Child And Thus Work Together With God To Save His Soul.
- 2. Teach The Child To Pray As Soon As He Can Speak.
- 3. Give The Child Nothing He Cries For And Only What Is Good For Him If He Asks For It Politely.
- 4. To Prevent Lying, Punish No Fault Which Is Freely Confessed, But Never Allow A Rebellious, Sinful Act To Go Unnoticed.
- 5. Commend And Reward Good Behavior.
- 6. Strictly Observe All Promises You Have Made To Your Child.
