Thought Of Our Passage: "God's Gifts Must Always Be Used Through Love For Edification Of His Church And To Win The Lost."

- 1. Verses 1-20 Tongues Versus Prophecy The Believer:

Verses 1-20 Paul's 4 Instructions To Believers Regarding Tongues & Prophecy:

- 1. Verse 1 Pursue Love and Spiritual Gifts: Pursue love, "follow after with the idea of catching it."
 - 1 Corinthians 12:31 Paul launched into the greatest chapter on love
 - 1 Corinthians 13
 - 1 Corinthians 13:13 but the greatest of these is love.

yet desire earnestly spiritual gifts, The problem with this church is that they wanted spiritual gifts but left God's love out of the operation of those gifts.

but especially that you may prophesy. Prophesy –which is forth-telling more than fore-telling; it is the proclaiming of God's
Word. It is a message given to us by God! **1 Thessalonians 5:20**

2. Verses 2-5 Priority Of Prophecy Over Tongues: 1 Corinthians 14:2

Purpose of Tongues Is To Speak To God: For one who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men, (or for men) but to God;

tongue – we are referring to "speaking a language given by the Spirit, either human or angelic language, that you have never previously studied or learned, or understand"

God Is Praised, But Others Don't Understand: for no one understands, but in His Spirit, He speaks mysteries.

Acts 2:4-6,11; Acts 10:46 with tongues and exalting God.

- 1 Corinthians 14:3 Purpose of Prophecy Is To Speak To Men: But one who prophesies <u>speaks to men</u> Paul said that <u>Prophecy has a threefold goal.</u>
- (1) Edification, (Build Up)
- (2) Exhortation, (Stir Up)
- (3) Consolation (Cheer Up)
- 1 Corinthians 14:4 Tongues Edify The Speaker: One who speaks in a tongue edifies himself; 1 Corinthians 13:5 (Love) it does not seek its own,

Prophecy Edifies The Church: but one who prophesies edifies the church. Proclaiming the Word is for the blessing of the church.

Edifying ourselves should be a byproduct of first ministering to others.

1 Corinthians 14:5 Tongues are a valid gift from God. Paul's desire.

Prophecy Is Better Than Tongues: but even more that you would prophesy; and greater is one who prophesies than one who speaks in tongues, Because when a person prophesies, they are blessing the church instead of themselves.

unless he interprets, so that the church may receive edifying. If a person spoke in tongues and it was interpreted, it was the blessing.

- 1 Corinthians 12:7 Gifts are to bless others, not self!
- 3. Verses 6-11 The Goal Is Communicating The Message:
 - 1 Corinthians 14:6

But now, brethren, The essence of tongues is personal edification; the church is not edified.

Paul's Ministry: if I come to you speaking in tongues, what will I profit you,

unless I speak to you either by way of revelation sharing <u>truth that</u> <u>was unknown</u>.

or of knowledge – the unfolding of the <u>divine Will of God</u>. Wisdom is the application in my life.

or of prophecy – foretelling and forth-telling.

or of teaching? – Doctrine, systematic teaching.

Verse 7 Communication In Music: 1 Corinthians 14:7

Verse 8 Communication In The Military: 1 Corinthians 14:8

Verses 9-11 Communication Daily: 1 Corinthians 14:9 Basic Communication:

- 1 Corinthians 14:10 (Genesis 11)
- 1 Corinthians 14:11 To Paul, communication was central to the divine purpose.
- 4. Verses 12-20 Paul's Directives: 1 Corinthians 14:12 So also you, since you are zealous of spiritual gifts, seek to abound for the edification of the church.

So also you, That wanting to use the gifts that God has given us is a good thing. That the gifts are from God but we need to think about blessing the church, how the church can be built up through the ministry of the gifts.

Verses 13-17 Prayer: 1 Corinthians 14:13 Therefore let one who speaks in a tongue <u>pray that he may interpret</u>. There is no benefit to the church if the message of tongues cannot be given out with the meaning.

1 Corinthians 14:14-15 What is the outcome then? Paul is saying that each has a purpose and a place.

I will pray with the spirit and I shall pray with the mind also; There is a time and place to pray in tongues. There is also a time when I need to speak in English too.

I will sing with the spirit and I will sing with the mind also. Romans 8:26; Jude 1:20

1 Corinthians 14:16 AMEN – ("So be it, Let it be so!") when they don't know what you are saying?

1 Corinthians 14:17-19

I desire to speak five words with my mind, so <u>that I may instruct</u> <u>others</u> also, rather than ten thousand words in a tongue.

1 Corinthians 14:27-28 live without tongues.

1 Corinthians 14:20 Brethren, Paul is speaking to Christians

do not be children in your thinking; That need to grow up!

yet in evil be infants, We should be like little babies when it comes to the wickedness

but in your thinking be mature. We need to grow up!

2. Verses 21-25 Tongues Versus Prophecy - The Non-Believer:

- 1 Corinthians 14:21 Isaiah 28:11-12
- **1 Corinthians 14:22 So then tongues are for a sign,** When we speak of a sign, it is to point to something.
- 1. Signs impart information.
- 2. Signs can be prophetic. Mark 6:30-44 Jesus feeds the people.
- **3. Signs convey authority.** Presidential seal, government seal.

but prophecy is for a sign, not to unbelievers, but to those who believe. God gets the believer's attention through prophecy by revealing His will, and unveiling His truths.

- 1 Corinthians 14:23 and ungifted men (new believer) or unbelievers enter, will they not say that you are mad? <u>YES!</u> 1 Corinthians 14:27 limited to 3 speakers.
- 1 Corinthians 14:24, 29-32

Conviction Thru The Word: The Word of God spoken by God's people will bring conviction to Man.

1 Corinthians 14:25 the secrets of his heart are disclosed; (Word of Knowledge!) Acts 2:37 pierced to the heart, "to be stuck with a dagger"

Application:

- **1.** Are My Convictions On Spiritual Gifts Based Upon Experience, People Or Upon Scripture?
- **2.** The Corinthian Church Magnified The Gift Of Tongues, Which Edifies The Speaker. Edifying Ourselves Should Be A Byproduct Of First Ministering To Others:
- **3.** Paul Said Prophecy Was Better Than Tongues. To Paul Communication Was Central To The Divine Purpose:
