2 Corinthians 4:1 we do not lose heart, 2 Corinthians 4:16 Therefore we do not lose heart,

lose heart - faint, "give in to evil, to behave badly, or lose courage."

2 Corinthians 1-5 Paul's Explanation Of His Ministry: Paul shares the power of the message from his heart. It comes from an all-powerful God!

1 Corinthians 12:7

Thought Of Our Passage: "The Believer's Calling Is A Result Of God's Mercy And Ourselves Being Honest In Walking In Humility"

1. Verse 1Determination2. Verses 2-4 Honesty3. Verses 5-6 Humility

1. Verse 1 Determination

2 Corinthians 4:1 Therefore, - Paul has spoken about the sufficiency of Christ. Our need is met in Jesus Christ. Paul had been given a NT ministry. Paul's ministry was that of grace. **2 Corinthians 3:18**

transformed – The English word metamorphosis is a transliteration of this Greek word. Metamorphosis describes the process that changes an insect from a caterpillar to a cocoon and then a butterfly.

since we have this ministry, - It is literally translated as "Therefore, seeing we have this <u>kind</u> of ministry."

What kind of ministry? The kind described in the previous chapter: a glorious ministry that brings men life, salvation, and righteousness; a ministry that is able to transform men's lives.

"The Law can bring us to Christ, but only grace can make us like Christ!"

Ministry Of Life: 2 Corinthians 3:6 but the Spirit gives life.

A ministry that gives life and freedom, not bondage. Not a ministry that focuses upon the externals but one that is concerned with the heart.

Ministry Of Liberty: 2 Corinthians 3:17 there is liberty.

Ministry Of Transformation: 2 Corinthians 3:18 being transformed into the same image from glory to glory,

Paul was conscious of a God-given great task: since we have this ministry,

Romans 1:16

Paul was conscious of great mercy: as we received mercy, This term mercy – "not getting what we deserve." Grace – "receiving what we don't deserve."

Mercy In Salvation: 1 Timothy 1:12-16

Romans 3:10 as it is written, "THERE IS NONE RIGHTEOUS, NOT EVEN ONE;

Mercy In Service: 1 Timothy 1:12

Paul looked at the ministry as a sacred trust! 1 Timothy 1:11

Paul was a realist: that the ministry entailed problems. **2 Timothy 1:11-12**

we do not lose heart, - How could Paul lose heart knowing that he was entrusted with a ministry? That God had saved him, called him to service?

God's Mercy, Grace And Calling Kept Paul From Quitting:

2. Verses 2-4 Honesty

2 Corinthians 4:2

Paul rejected three faulty areas of motivation by the false teachers:

- **#1. Reject Hidden Dishonesty: but we have renounced the things hidden –** "dishonesty" **because of shame,** – "to be ashamed, to handle with unclean hands."
- **#2. Reject Walking In Craftiness: not walking in craftiness** "The fisherman that uses bait to lure away a fish, to do whatever one pleases to achieve a certain goal." **"The End Justifies The Means!"**
- **#3. Reject Corrupting The Word Of God: or adulterating the word of God,** the word **adulterating** – "to make corrupt" Lies, halftruths, mixture, little truth with a big lie!

2 Timothy 4:1-3

Proof- Texting – Come with a preconceived idea and find a verse to back it up!

Positive: but by the manifestation of truth - Let the truth stand on its own.

John 17:17 "Sanctify them in the truth; Thy word is truth.

Positive: commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God. Paul said, I was honest all the time, and my conscience is laid bare before the Lord.

2 Corinthians 4:3 it is veiled (hid) to those who are perishing,

The gospel message is veiled or covered. They are perishing because they have rejected the message.

1 Corinthians 1:18

Why is the gospel veiled? It's because persons have rejected the truth, and Satan has blinded their minds.

2 Corinthians 4:4 in whose case the god of this world

This is the Devil. He is called the god of this world because the world is under his power. **1 John 5:19**

has blinded the minds of the unbelieving,

The Devil uses deception, half-truths, partial truths to keep people under his power. **Romans 1:25**

so that they might not see the light - When the Bible uses the term light, it is a metaphor for truth. **John 3:19-21**

of the gospel of the glory of Christ, - The message is one that is glorious.

Christ, who is the image of God. The term **image –** "*The exact likeness."* **Image –** Greek word *eikon* – by which we get our word *Icon, which means image or representation.*

Jesus is the revelation of what God is really like, not a cold plaster cast but the <u>character</u> and <u>portrait</u> of God.

Hebrews 1:3

exact representation – means the impression left by a die on a coin or a seal on wax. He is the exact impress of the essence of God.

<u>3. Verses 5-6 Humility</u>

2 Corinthians 4:5 For we do not preach (Keep on preaching) **ourselves** (No man can save another man)

2 Corinthians 1:9, I don't trust myself
2 Corinthians 3:1-5 I don't commend myself,
2 Corinthians 4:5 I don't preach myself

but Christ Jesus as Lord, (God that became man) Jesus is Lord, master. Put the light on Jesus. (Death, burial, and resurrection)

and ourselves as your bond-servants for Jesus' sake. We are servants of God!

2 Corinthians 4:6 For God, who said, "Light shall shine out of darkness," Genesis 1:1-5

is the One who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ. Paul compares conversion to creation!

Ephesians 4:17-18

Application: "How To Guard Against Losing Heart"

- 1. Determination We Have Been Entrusted With A Great Task.
- 2. Honesty We Have The Truth It Will Speak For Itself.
- 3. Humility We Have To Know It Is Not Us But Him.
