Series "Knowing The Exact Truth" "My God Will Supply" Luke 12:22-34 Study-54

Our English word **Worry -** comes from an old Anglo-Saxon word that means "to strangle"

Note what Jesus says about worry!

Verse 22 do not worry about your life,

Verse 29 and do not keep worrying.

Verse 32 "Do not be afraid, little flock,

Context - Jesus had just spoken about Greed. **Greed -** you can never get enough! **Those that have! (Getting Ahead)**

Jesus now speaks about Worry - being afraid to not <u>have</u> enough! **Those that have not! (Getting By)**

"Greed can never get enough, worry is afraid it may not have enough, Worry is the emotional reward of material preoccupation"

Luke 9:51-19:27 The Rejection Of The Son Of Man:

Luke 12 - Hindrances To Holiness:

Verses 1-12 Be Careful Lest Satan Hinder You - The Fear Of Man: Verses 13-34 Be Confident God Will Not Fail You - Love Of Money: Passage is also recorded in Matthew 6:19-34

Thought Of Our Passage: "Believers Have A Divine Perspective Towards Material Possessions Knowing That Our Father Will Provide For Our Needs."

Seven Reasons To Trust God To Supply Our Need:

1. Verses 22-23 Not Trusting God Is Shortsighted

Luke 12:22

And He said to His disciples,

worry is one of the besetting sins of believers.

"For this reason I say to you,

Jesus was asked by a man to help him divide up a family inheritance. Jesus said No! Because the real issue was greed.

This is the parable about "The Rich Fool".

A man that was wealthy and only thought of himself.

Luke 12:19-21

"For this reason As true <u>disciples of Jesus, we are not "Fools"</u> that are living for self, but are investing in eternal things.

do not worry about your life, The word **worry, anxious –** "to be divided, to be torn apart, divide the mind, Latin to choke"

about your life, we are not to be torn apart as to our lives.

2 Thessalonians 3:10 If you don't work then you cannot eat! 1 Timothy 5:8

If riches are your god, then you have reason to worry. If Jesus is your God, You will not put your trust in the things of this world!

as to what <u>you will eat;</u> nor for your body, as to what <u>you will put</u> <u>on.</u> It seems that these are the two top areas for Americans. Food and clothing.

The first-century conditions were tough:

- 1. Conditions could be likened to third-world countries.
- 2. Workers were paid every day so they could exist.
- 3. Taxed 40% on the average worker.

Luke 12:23 You would never know it judging from the world's priorities! Luke 4:4

<u>Jesus Taught Us to Pray</u> - **Give us this day our daily bread;** Dependence upon Him,

<u>Don't get distracted</u> - **Luke10:38-42** Martha got distracted **Shortsighted - more to life.**

2. Verse 24 Not Trusting God Is Senseless:

Luke 12:24 "Consider the ravens, unclean animals Leviticus 11:15 (God still cares for them) Birds have total dependence upon God's provisions:

and yet God feeds them; how much more valuable you are than the birds! God provides for the birds. He created them and will also sustain them.

Argument from the lesser to the greater. 1 Peter 5:7

<u>Senseless</u> - God will take care

3. Verses 25-26 Not Trusting God Is Futile:

Luke 12:25 hour some translations say **cubit -** a measurement of about 18-21 inches (From the index finger to the elbow).

This is a figure of speech. You can't add height, or length, to our lives.

It will not make you live longer - It does not create a better quality of life. It Is Useless.

Luke 12:26 "If then you cannot do even a very little thing, grow 18 inches, add time by anxiety? There Is Nothing Positive Through Worry!

why do you worry about other matters?

It is useless, it is senseless to worry! "People get ulcers, not so much from what they eat, as from what eats them" <u>Futile</u>:

4. Verses 27-28 Not Trusting God Is Faithless:

Luke 12:27 "Consider the lilies, look at, observe the flowers. Jesus is speaking about the common wildflowers of the field. "California Poppies" cactus flowers.

how they grow; they neither toil nor spin;

The plants don't tell God when it is time to rain, warm-up, or cool down.

but I tell you, not even Solomon in all his glory clothed himself like one of these. A preverbally saying, "Solomon in all of his glory" 1 Kings 10:4-5,21, 23

Luke 12:28 "But if God so (Since God) clothes the grass in the field, which is alive today It is God who gives life.

and tomorrow is thrown into the furnace,

Wild followers were used for fuel for baking.

how much more will He clothe you? You men of little faith! If God would take the time and preparations to cause flowers to bloom

little faith - "little or small faith" It's an issue of not trusting our Father. **Oswald Chambers** in **"Run Today's Race"** said, "All of our fret and worry is caused by calculating without God" **Faithless:**

5. Verses 29-30 Not Trusting God Is For The Unsaved:

Luke 12:29 and do not keep worrying. Stop being doubtful. (Habitual doubting!) "Self-Consuming Care, Opposite of Trust"

Luke 12:30 The term "nations" could be used as "Gentiles," a term used by the Jews to speak of non-Jewish people who did not worship the true and living God.

gods of the Greeks, and Romans of Greek Mythology Insufficient, Lied, Cheated, got angry, Murdered, less than human.

Gentiles had anxiety because their gods could not be trusted.

of the world eagerly seek; anxiety over food and clothing is sought after by the heathen, non-believing people.

Our God is so good and righteous, He will always take care of His own. **The Unsaved Worry:**

6. Verses 30-32 Not Trusting God Denies Sonship:

Luke 12:30 but your Father knows that you need these things.

What an insult to God when we worry!

It is denying that we have a heavenly father who knows and cares.

World's Contingency - things happen without rhyme or reason. **World's Fatalism -** What is to be will happen. (Meant to be)

Christian's Doctrine of Certainty - your Father

The son, or daughter, of God is in the hands of a LIVING LOVING FATHER, WHO WILL TAKE CARE OF THEM BECAUSE THEY ARE HIS. HE IS THEIR FATHER!

your Father - (Power, Ability and is Willingness)

The world continues without the awareness of a loving heavenly Father that wants to meet our needs! (Power and Ability)

Luke 12:31 "But if you want an area of focus, something that you should focus upon, this is what it should be! seek His kingdom, "Idea of a hunter seeking his prey" (Aim) His purpose, priorities, His Power in our lives and those around us.

and these things will be added to you. That if we will put God's priorities first all other things will fall into their right order.

Luke 12:32 "Do not be afraid, little flock, (Only Time Used) "It is a little flock but remember who it belongs to" Small means special care!

Romans 8:31 If God is for us, who is against us?

for your Father has chosen gladly to give you the kingdom. It is God's desire and plan to give us the peace, power and position of His reign. **Denies Sonship:**

7. Verses 33-34 Not Trusting God Is Seeking The Wrong Treasure:

Luke 12:33 "Sell your possessions and give to charity;
Is Jesus telling every believer to sell all if they are to be His followers?

No! we must "hang loose" when it comes to this world's goods. It is not wrong to own things so long as things do not own us.

make yourselves money belts which do not wear out, Investing in the eternal versus the temporal.

Only Way To Truly Protect Your Treasure Is To Invest In Heaven:

Luke 12:34 "Heart And Treasure Go Together" Where is our heart?
