"The God Of All Comfort" 2 Corinthians 1:3-11

Jeremiah 29:13 If you look for me wholeheartedly, you will find me.

2 Corinthians was penned by the Apostle Paul during a time of Great Personal Affliction!

Paul had previously written 1 Corinthians 16:9

Note With "Opportunities" Also Comes "Opposition!"

The Purpose Of 2 Corinthians: To address false teachers that had infiltrated the Corinthian assembly that questioned both Paul's <u>personal integrity</u> and <u>apostolic authority</u>.

Key Word: "Comfort" Encouragement is used in one form or another **29 times**

Theme: "Power Out Of Weakness"

Verse 4 Affliction 2 times

Verse 5 Sufferings,

Verse 6 Affliction, Suffering, Suffer,

Verse 7 Suffering,

Verse 8 Affliction,

Job 5:7 For man is born for trouble, As sparks fly upward.

Note with "Suffering" 8 times, there is also God's "Comfort" 10 times Verses 1-7

Thought Of Our Passage: "When Hurting, Remember Who God Is So We Can Comfort Others, And Keep Trusting, And Seeking Him."

- 3 Things To Remember About God When We Are Hurting:
- 1. God Is To Be Blessed:

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,

Notice that Paul is blessing God in his sufferings!

Job's Example: (Lost Family 7 sons, 3 daughters, Business and Possessions) **Job 1:20-21**

Job 2 (Job finally looses his health) Job's wife said, "Curse God and die!"
Psalm 34:1-4

2. God Is The Source Of Mercies: the Father of mercies

Father – "the originator, the source of, the origin" Satan John 8:44 "Father of lies"

Mercy has been defined as "not getting what we deserve" Note it is plural **mercies** which means that "God has an allowance for mercy in every conceivable way"

Psalms 145:9

We need mercy because we are sinners! (Mercy Is Found At The Cross!)

3. God Is The God Of All Comfort: (Accomplished Through Christ's Death, Burial And Resurrection) God of all comfort;

The word **comfort** is used **10 times** in Verses 1-7

Comfort – Literally: "to call to one's side to strengthen" (Not a lighter load but a stronger back)

God Gives Comfort Not Sympathy – Sympathy can weaken us. God gives strength, stands at our side.

God uses people to comfort us. Barnabas - "son of encouragement"

1 Peter 5:7, 10

We Need To Remember Who God Is! Mark 4:38-40

Right Now We As Believers Are Being Tested With A Storm (Covid19) – Don't Forget Who God Is!

2. Verses - 4-7 Remember To Comfort Others:

2 Corinthians 1:4 who comforts us in all our affliction

This word **affliction** means "pressure" God will comfort us, this is what the promise is.

Some Afflictions Are The Result Of Sin - They are brought on because of sin. God loves us so much that He will not allow us to sin successfully.

Abraham - Fell into fear and lied about his wife.

Jacob - Was nicknamed the trickster, was always scheming.

Jonah - Disobeyed the Lord and was eaten up by a whale.

<u>Some Afflictions Are For Our Growth</u> - These are brought on by the Lord, to make us more like Jesus.

Paul - He had a thorn in his flesh - escape, endure, but enlist

so that we will be able to comfort those who are in any affliction with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God.

We can become a reservoir of self, instead of a channel of blessing.

Note: God's comfort is not given to us but is actually <u>loaned</u>. God expects us to pass it on to others!

2 Corinthians 1:5 For just as the sufferings of Christ are ours in abundance, good to remember!

sufferings of Christ Philippians 3:10

so also our comfort is abundant through Christ.

Note God's Mathematics! That with the afflictions God doubles down the comfort.

2 Corinthians 1:6

- 1. Our Affliction Can Result In Comfort And Salvation To Others: (Watching Us)
- 2. Our Comfort Brings Both Comfort, And Patience In Character To Others:

2 Corinthians 1:7 and our <u>hope</u> for you is firmly grounded, What a difference Jesus Christ makes. **Romans 15:4**

Hope – "A Sure Expectation Of A Future Event!"

knowing that as you are sharers of our sufferings, so also you are sharers of our comfort.

Sharers Of Suffering: Philippians 1:29-30

Sharers Of Comfort: (Comfort, God's Help In Our Suffering)

Remember To Comfort Others: (Believers Are Channels, Not Reservoirs.)

3. Verses - 8-10 Remember To Keep Trusting God:

2 Corinthians 1:8 For we do not want you to be unaware, brethren, of our affliction

Paul is admitting his shortcomings so that the believers can learn from Paul, pray for Paul.

which came to us in Asia, possibly the riot at Ephesus (Acts 19:23-41) 2 Corinthians 7:5

- **3 Important Facts About Trusting In God:**
- 1. Trust In God Who Can Strengthen Us: that we were burdened excessively, beyond our strength, so that we despaired even of life; God allows only that which we can take! 1 Corinthians 10:13
 - 2 Corinthians 1:9
- 2. In God Alone We Must Trust: Why does God bring us to death's door? so that we would not trust in ourselves, but in God who raises the dead;

but in God who raises the dead;

That was a lesson that Abraham learned.

- 2 Corinthians 1:10
- 3. Trusting A Faithful God Who Will Deliver Us:

(Past Deliverance) who delivered us from so great a peril of death,

(Future Deliverance) and will deliver us,

(Present Deliverance) He on whom <u>we have set</u> our hope. And He will yet deliver us,

God Does Not Always Immediately Deliver, He does not do it the same way. All of the disciples with exception of John were martyred (Taken out or taken through!) Genesis 50:20

Remember Keep Trusting God:

4. Verse - 11 Remember To Pray:

2 Corinthians 1:11

Praying For Others: you also joining in helping us through your prayers,

helping us

No greater way to help than to pray!

Prayer Is Dependence Upon God: When we pray we are asking God to step in. We are relying on the Lord for strength and for Him to work.

Praying Will Result In Thanksgiving: so that thanks may be given by many persons on our behalf for the favor bestowed on us through the prayers of many.

Remember To Pray And Trust God:

Application:

- **1. Remember Who God Is:** God Is Always To Be Blessed, God Is The Author of All Mercies, And The God Of All Comfort.
- **2. Remember To Comfort Others:** Comfort Is Loaned, Not Given. Comfort Starts With Us And Finishes In Blessing Others.
- **3. Remember To Trust God:** In God Who Can Strengthen Us. In God Who Wants Us To Fully Trust Him. In God Who Will Surely Deliver Us.
- 4. Remember To Pray: When We Pray For Others, It Will Result In Praise.
