"His Name Will Be Called Wonderful" Isaiah 9:6 Sunday, December 20, 2020

Isaiah 9:6 is a "Birth Announcement" which was announced 700 years <u>Before</u>, not <u>After</u> the Birth of Jesus Christ!

Isaiah saw into the Future; The Messiah's <u>Nature</u> and <u>Mission</u> and drew word pictures of Him through His names.

"This Birth Announcement" Contains <u>5 Names given to Jesus</u> that describe Jesus as "The Ultimate, and Greatest Gift of All!"

Matthew 1:21 Jesus - "the Lord is Salvation."

Notice it is said that He <u>will be born.</u> The Son Of God came as a man, He was the "Son of God/ Son of Man" and came into this sinful world. (Not man becoming God! "God Coming In The Flesh."

He was **given.** Jesus Christ was the Father's Love Gift to this sinful world (The Gift Of God In The Flesh, The Savior)

And the government will rest on His shoulders; (Millennial Reign, eternity)

Between the words **us; And** is a period of 1900 years.

Thought Of Our Passage: "Jesus Is God's Ultimate Gift, Meeting The Dullness, Decisions, Demands, Dimensions, And Disturbances Of Life."

I want to look at <u>5 Names</u> that were given to Jesus:

1. Wonderful – Jesus Is The Answer To The Dullness Of Life:

Someone made the observation that half the sins of mankind are committed because of boredom. Matthew 18:3

Wonder VS. Novelty:

Novelty: Electronic gadgets – Communications – Our Residents –

Wonder: What is Wonder? The word wonderful; Isaiah uses means - "to separate, to distinguish." Throughout the Old Testament, it is translated different ways. It carries the basic meaning of "being unique and different."

Wonder Involves Depth - It <u>changes the person enriching them and never leaving them the same.</u>

Wonder Creates an Attitude of Humility - Psalm 8:3-4

True Wonder Involves the Whole Person - Mind, heart, and will.

We Live In A Mechanical World - Science and technology have robbed us of our heavenly Father's making of the lilies, the sparrows.

We Live In A Commercial World - The question of our day is "Does it work?" and "Does it pay?" <u>Value and prices.</u>

We Live In A Busy World - How full our schedules are.

We Live In An Artificial World -

The Greatest Substitute Is Sin - It lies at the root of the whole issue.

The dullness of life is not caused by the circumstances of life around me but the <u>condition of my heart inside me!</u>

2. Counselor – Jesus Takes Care Of The Decisions Of Life: Counselor (Speaks of counsel to the leader of a Nation)

John 6:68 You have words of eternal life.

Jesus is **Counselor** tells us that we are in need of counsel. **Jeremiah 10:23**

The Heart is Selfish and Deceitful, Jeremiah 17:9

The Mind is also Extremely Limited. Romans 12:2

The <u>heart</u> the <u>mind</u> (Flesh) need help. We also have the temptations of the (World) and the (Devil). Which blinds the mind.

When we ask for Counsel, we are not asking for <u>Luxury</u>, but a <u>Necessity</u>.

Jesus Has All Wisdom - Colossians 2:3

<u>Jesus Encourages Us</u> - Psalms 46:1

Jesus Is Patient With Us - John 16:12

Jesus Knows Our Heart: The Condition Of The Church - Revelation 1:14

Jesus Prays for us - Hebrews 7:25

How Does Jesus Counsel Us? <u>Through His Word:</u> When the Bible speaks, God speaks! Psalm 119:24, 98-100

Be willing to seek His Counsel and obey it. That means: Wait for it.

3. The Mighty God - Jesus Takes Care Of The Demands Of Life:

Admit our own weakness, yield to Him by faith, and receive His power by faith.

Jesus <u>declared to be God</u>. He <u>was worshipped</u>, He <u>performed miracles</u>, He demonstrated <u>His power by the resurrection</u>, John 10:18

Philippians 4:19; 2 Corinthians 12:7-10

2 Chronicles 16:9 whose heart is completely His. He is not looking for "a perfect heart" because they don't exist, but a <u>devoted heart</u> to Him. A heart that is trusting Him.

Ephesians 3:20

<u>4. The Everlasting Father</u> – Jesus Takes Care Of The Dimensions Of Life: We were made for eternity. Jesus Christ is the Father of Eternity as Savior and Lord.

Father - OT use means: "originator of, or author of." Jesus called Satan "The father of lies" John 8:44

Jesus is called **The Everlasting Father -** He is the *Father - Originator - of Eternity!"*

God had no beginning and has no end. (Eternality) Man has a beginning but has no end. **John 6:68**

Jesus revealed what flesh and spirit are together. John 3:16

When Jesus was born, time and eternity met in a person.

When Jesus died, time and eternity met in a price - paid for sin -

Jesus controls time.

1 John 2:17

A whole new dimension of eternity; we begin to live a whole new life with Jesus Christ.

5. Prince Of Peace - Jesus Takes Care Of The Disturbances Of Life:

Peace comes from the inside out, not from the outside in. It depends upon who is in control, Self or Christ.

Peace From The New Birth - Colossians 1:20; Romans 5:1

Jesus Offers Peace And Companionship - Peace is a person that is also a gift. John 14:27
