1 Corinthians 10 Paul uses Israel as an example of **Liberty Leading to Destruction.**

Thought Of Our Passage: "The Possession And The Awareness Of The Believers' Liberty Does Not Guarantee The Enjoyment Of Our Liberty."

1. Verses 1-4 Blessings Of The Christian Life

1 Corinthians 10:1 For or moreover Joins what Paul has just said in 1 Corinthians 9:27

I do not want you to be unaware,

That not being informed can cause problems.

brethren, Now Paul is speaking to those that are believers. Some of them were also Jewish.

that our fathers were all - notice the word **all** that is used **10 times**. He is making it clear that all of Israel <u>experienced the same things</u> and had the <u>same opportunities</u>.

(Blessing Of Guidance) under the cloud, - This is God protecting Israel in the wilderness by day. Exodus 13:21-22; Psalm 105:39

(Blessing Of Deliverance) and all passed through the sea; This is a reference to the deliverance by God from Egypt by way of the Red Sea.

1 Corinthians 10:2 (Blessing Of Assurance) Baptized – "Believers' identification with Jesus Christ, death burial and resurrection, walking in new life"

Purpose: To show a complete break from the old world (Egypt)

1 Corinthians 10:3 (Blessing Of Sustenance) spiritual food – Because of where it came from, heaven. **John 6:32-33**

Psalm 78:25; Exodus 16:14-15 The word Manna - means "What is it?"

1 Corinthians 10:4 and all drank the same spiritual drink, - When we speak of drinking, we are often speaking about taking in life. Exodus 17:1,6

The provisions that Jesus provided was evidence of His presence. The cloud and the pillar of fire – His presence. Manna – food; Their sandals never wore out –

2. Verses 5-10 Failures Of The Christian Life

1 Corinthians 10:5 Nevertheless, Paul has spoken how the Lord has been so good to Israel by providing for their needs, deliverance.

with most of them God was not well-pleased; That is a gracious way of saying it.

for they were laid low in the wilderness. literally "wherever they went, there were graves"

Numbers 14:29

God was pleased with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob but not the practice of the people.

1 Corinthians 10:6 Now these things happened as examples for us, God is saying that these things can teach us.

Paul Gives 5 Examples That We Can Learn From Israel's History:

1. Verse 6 Warning Against Lust: so that we would not crave evil things as they also craved.

This is the bottom line or the heart of the problem.

2. Verse 7 Warning Against The Sin Of Idolatry: 1 Corinthians 10:7 Exodus 32:1-6

Do not be idolaters as some of them were; This was a sin that some of the Corinthians were committing. **1 John 5:21 Little children, guard yourselves from idols.**

3. Verse 8 Warning Against The Sin Of Immorality: 1 Corinthians 10:8 You turn from God and out goes morals.

Numbers 25:1-2 Numbers 25:9 And those who died by the plague were 24,000. This passage says 24,000... is this a discrepancy? No! The plague went on and took another 1,000. That day, it was 23,000 a day or so later it took another thousand.

Hebrews 13:4

4. Verse 9 Warning Against The Sin Of Trying The Lord:
1 Corinthians 10:9 Nor let us try the Lord, How do we try the Lord? When we show dissatisfaction for His gracious provision, protection of the basic necessities of life.

Numbers 21:4-9

5. Verse 10 Warning Against The Sin Of Murmuring: 1 Corinthians 10:10

grumble - *It is audible grumbling, unwarranted dissatisfaction*. 2 million people with nothing to complain about! Not real issues just complaints about this and that!

Numbers 14:2,36

3. Verses 11-15 Lessons For The Christian Life

1 Corinthians 10:11

Paul Gives 4 Purposes For History:

1. To Warn Us: Now these things happened to them as an example, and they were written for our instruction, (Admonition) "*warning and correction designed to change past behavior and introduce new patterns of life"*

upon whom the ends of the ages have come.

We can learn and use the wealth of instruction that has been handed down through all the years.

1 Corinthians 10:12

2. To Keep Us From Pride: Therefore let him who thinks he stands take heed that he does not fall. You better take to heart and really consider the pitfalls that are before you! Proverbs 16:18

1 Corinthians 10:13

3. To Give Us Victory Over Temptations: No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man;

Ecclesiastes 1:9-10

and God is faithful,

When we say that we are over our heads in temptation we are denying God's faithfulness.

Others have resisted Temptation and so can we: who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able,

God knows what we can handle.

God will always show us a way out: but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also,

Escape – Nautical term "used of sailors that would lighten their ship in the midst of a storm by throwing overboard weighty or useless cargo" (Gold, Silver)

so that you will be able to endure it.

God wants us to learn and grow.

1 Corinthians 10:14 Therefore,

What is the **Therefore, There for?** These believers were playing in the allowable and it was becoming sinful.

Idolatry – "any object or thing that takes the rightful place of God"

1 John 5:21 Little children, guard yourselves from idols.

1 Corinthians 10:15

4. To Give Us Discernment: I speak as to wise men;

"those of intelligent common sense" To give moral and spiritual discernment about present problems.

you judge what I say.

You need to look and take to heart what I am saying to you!
