Recognize => to know, to understand.

Labor => to feel fatigue; by implication, to work hard: — (bestow) labour, toil, be wearied. To grow weary, tired, exhausted, to labour with wearisome effort, to toil with bodily labour

Over You => rule, maintain, be over; to set or place before, to set over, to be over, to superintend, preside over => **to be a protector or guardian to give aid, to care for, give attention to.**

Lord => God, Lord, Master, Supreme in authority, Master

Admonish => to put in mind, (by implication) to caution or reprove gently: — admonish, warn. => **exhort**
