1. Verses 1:27-30 Stay Strong:

Therefore?

To stand firm amid persecution.

Philippians 1:27-30

Three encouragements in the previous verses.

- **1.** Spiritual battles prove our salvation, which is to them a proof of perdition, but to you of salvation
- 2. We suffer for His Sake but also to suffer for His sake
- **3.** others are suffering the same conflict. *having the same conflict*

2. Verses 2:1-4 Stay United:

If there is any consolation in Christ: If there is any . . . comfort of love: If there is any . . . fellowship of the Spirit: If there is any . . . affection and mercy:

Verse 2 gives us: The Goal

Verse 3 tells us: How to Achieve It

<u>The Goal</u>

Verse 2 fulfill my joy by being like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind.

Paul now gives us four specific ways, in which their spiritual unity would be realized.

- 1. LIKE MINDED
- 2. SAME LOVE
- 3. ONE ACCORD
- 4. ONE MIND

3. Verses 2:5-11 Stay Humble

Jesus gives us four examples to follow.

- He thinks of others; not himself
 Verse 5-6 Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God,
- He serves
 Verse 7 but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.
- 3. He sacrifices

Verse 8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to *the point of* death, even the death of the cross.

4. He glorifies God

Verse 9-11 Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and *that* every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ *is* Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
