### 1. Verses- 21-22 The Obstacles Of Faith:

Matthew 15:18-20

Tyre the word Literally - "The Rock"

Note the obstacles that this woman was up against:

- 1. Her Nationality Canaanite a Gentile, (Mark 7:26) of the Syrophoenician race.
- 2. Her Gender woman
- <u>3. Demon Possession -</u> my daughter is cruelly demonpossessed."

my daughter Literally translated, "Darling little girl."

is cruelly – "Miserable, very sick" demon-possessed." Mark 7:25 unclean spirit,

Affliction <u>Can</u> Prove To Be A Blessing To Ones Soul: and began to cry out, saying, "Have mercy on me,

Note The Object of Her Faith was God. O Lord

# 2. Verses-23-26 The Drawing Of Faith:

Why Is Jesus Silent? But He did not answer her a word.

- 1. Jesus Desired Seclusion Mark 7:24
- 2. She addressed Him as "Son of David", but as a Gentile she had no claim on the Jewish Messiah. She was not a party to the Covenant.
- 3. She must learn that Jesus ministry was primarily to Israel, and that it was through them that the blessings of the Covenant would ultimately reach the Gentiles. John 4:21-23
- 4. As always Jesus wished to draw out her faith.

She was not silenced by Jesus silence!
