# 1. Verse 12 – Example To Others:

- 1 Tim 4:12
- 1 Tim 4:6-11 God Centered Ministry (A Good Minister of Jesus Christ)
- 1 Tim 4:12-16 An Enduring Ministry (Lasting Fruitful Ministry)

"look down" - "despise"; literally means "to look down mentally"

"show yourself an example of those who believe." – The command actually reads, "keep on becoming"

The term "example" in the Greek is "the imprinted mark of a firm, heavy blow upon metal."

- 1 Thessalonians 1:5-6

1. "speech" – (Word) an example in his speech, both public and private.

2. "conduct" - Timothy's lifestyle was to be praiseworthy.

- 3. "love" Greek word (agapēi); "the love of decision, of will, self-denial, self-sacrificing to benefit others, deliberate choice"
  - 1 Timothy 1:5
  - 1 Thessalonians 2:7-12
  - 1 John 4:20-21

Philippians 2:17

- 4. "faith" Not one's belief; Means "one's faithfulness or unswerving commitment"
  - 1 Corinthians 4:2
- 5. "purity" "manifesting a holy life of dedication before God and in his dealings with others, a sexual purity in actions and intentions of the heart"
  - 1 Timothy 3:2
  - 2 Timothy 2:22

# 2. Verse 13 - Emphasize God's Word:

1 Tim 4:13

"give attention" – "an inner devotion and a total absorption in the task." Paul charged his associate to "give attendance" to 3 areas of public ministry.

1. To Reading: (The Scriptures Are The Authority) – "to the public reading of Scripture,"

Colossians 4:16

1 Thessalonians 5:27

2. To Exhortation: (Application) – "to exhortation" (Preaching); The term exhortation – means "to call beside, to rebuke, warn, counsel, or comfort always involves a binding of the conscience."

The idea of preaching being Spirit directed activity, communicating God's message to the people. Believers and non-believers, The conviction that God's Word is always relevant to God's people!

3. To Teaching: (Exposition) – "and teaching."; (Doctrinal) used 15X in Pastoral Epistles. It involves the systematic explanation of the Word of God.

Nehemiah 8:8

The pastor was to read the Word, explain it, and apply it.

"Biblical Exposition"; To expound Scripture is to open up the inspired text with such faithfulness and sensitivity that God's voice is heard and his people obey him.

# 3. Verse 14 – Exercise Your Spiritual Gifts:

1 Tim 4:14

"Do not neglect" – literally means "be not careless about"; It denotes a lack of genuine concern.

You Have A Spiritual Gift – "the spiritual gift within you,"; The term "gift" is the Greek word charisma. It simply means "a gracious gift from God."

The Gift Was Confirmed By Revelation – "which was bestowed upon you through prophetic utterance"; 1 Tim 1:18 – Paul himself, Acts 13:2

The Gift Was Recognized By Others – "with the laying on of hands by the presbytery."

## 4. Verse 15 – Excel In Jesus:

1 Tim 4:15

(Attitude) "Take pains with these things;" – "Thinking through beforehand, planning, strategizing, premeditating" "meditate"

(Actions) "be absorbed in them," – literally reads "be in them"

2 Timothy 4:2

Progressing In Spiritual Growth: "so that your progress may be evident to all."

progress literally means "to cut toward"

#### 5. Verse 16 - Examine Yourself:

1 Tim 4:16

Vigilance: "Pay close attention" – "to hold upon, to fasten attention upon"

1 Peter 5:8

Personal Life - "to yourself," - "Himself"

Theological Life – "and to your teaching;"
