- 1. Peck-measure "not brought to be put under a peck-measure,"
- 2. Bed "under a bed?"
- 3. Lampstand "Is it not brought to be put on the lampstand?"

Christians As Light:

- 1. Reminder To Believers That Our Purpose Is Not To Conceal God's Revelation, But To Openly Display It For Others To Benefit From.
- 2. Our Life In Truth Is A Rebuke To The Unbelievers, Who Refuse To Come To The Light, Even Though It Is So Readily Available.
