Seek – seek, and you shall find; Greek is in the present imperative, which means to "keep on seeking Him" The idea of getting up looking around.

Knock – knock, and it shall be opened to you. Greek is in the present imperative, which means "keep on knocking, coming to Him" The idea of asking plus persevering like someone who keeps pounding on a door.
