Mark 5:21 - "a great multitude gathered about Him;"

Mark Records 2 Miracles: A Woman Hemorrhaging to Death, And Raising A Little Girl From The Dead; "Humanly Impossible Situations"

Both Stories reveal that the Savior is ever willing and ready to respond to Faith!

- 1. Mark 4:35-41 Jesus Demonstrated His authority over Creation (Calms Storm)
- 2. Mark 5:1-20 Jesus Demonstrated Authority over "Satan" (Legion of Demons)
- 3. Mark 5:21-43 Jesus Demonstrates Authority over "Sickness and Death"

All 3 Gospels – Matt 9:18-26; Mark 5:21-43; Luke 8:40-56

1. Verses 21-24 - Jesus And The Official:

Mark 5:21

Mark 5:1

Mark 5:17

Mark 5:22

"And one of the synagogue officials" – The position of oversight and order over the synagogue.

"named Jairus" - His name means "whom God enlightens"

4 Observation's Regarding Jairus Coming To Jesus:

1. This Man Humbled Himself – "came up, and upon seeing Him, fell at His feet."

- 2. Jairus Put His Relationships On The Line -
- 3. Jairus Placed His Position On The Line -

Mark 5:23

4. He Came In Desperation – "and entreated Him earnestly,": Literally – "Begging repeatedly again and again"

"My little daughter is at the point of death;" — "Is at her last gasp!" Luke 8:42

Absolutely no one escapes the situation of Jairus. Every one of us will find ourselves in his sandals.

Mark 5:24

"pressing in on Him." – "pressed Him together"

2. Verses 25-34 - Jesus And The Woman:

Mark 5:25

Verses 25-26 – Her Condition: "who had had a hemorrhage", Lev. 15:25-27

"for twelve years," – Mark 5:42 Jairus – daughter is 12. (Israel 12 Tribes)

Mark 5:26

- 1. "Endured much" The treatment was severe. (Cure worse than ailment)
- 2. "Many physicians" She had tried many approaches and treatments.
- 3. "Spent all her money" Medical costs had depleted her resources.
- 4. "Not helped at all" Wasted time, wasted money
- 5. "Actually condition had gotten worse" Progressively worse.

Luke 8:43

Verses 27-29 – Her Cure: Mark 5:27-28

She is coming to the <u>Healer</u> not the <u>Savior</u>.

Mark 5:29

Verses 30-34 – Her Confession: Mark 5:30

Immediately (49X), power "dynamis dynamic power"

The model for all ministry, "Ministry that costs little produces little"

Jesus knew who it was, but He wanted to draw her out. Matthew 10:32-33

It was a silent faith that must be exposed! (Like a smoldering wick, it must be ignited!)

Mark 5:31

There is a big difference between "Touching Jesus" and "Trusting Jesus!"

Mark 5:32-34

"Daughter," – This is the only recorded place where Jesus calls a woman this word.

"your faith has made you well;" – "has saved you" not a touch, superstition, but faith! Healed By faith.

"go in peace, and be healed of your affliction." Peace is the result of the forgiveness of her sins. She received more than a healing.

3. Verses 35-43 - Jesus And The Little Girl:

Mark 5:35

"why trouble the Teacher anymore?" Classic Response: "if Jesus had really cared, He would not have let her die in the first place"

Mark 5:36

Jesus Makes 4 Statements In The Face Of Death:

1. When Facing Death, We Must Keep The Faith: "Do not be afraid any longer, only believe."

Romans 10:17

Mark 5:37-38

"commotion," - "tumult, uproar"

Mark 5:39

2. Jesus Speaks Words Of Hope: "The child has not died, but is asleep." John 11:11

Eph 2:1

Death is the result of sin. Romans 6:23; Rev 20

Mark 5:40-41

3. Words Of Love: "Little girl," Could be translated "Little Lamb"; John 11 3X It says, Jesus loved Lazarus

"I say to you," - Notice "I", This is God speaking here; only God has authority

4. Word Of Power: "I say to you, arise!" Rev 20:11

Mark 5:42 – "immediately the girl rose and began to walk;"

Mark 5:43

Application:

- 1. Jesus And Jairus Lay Aside Pride And Come To Jesus.
- 2. Jesus And The Woman No Matter How Small Our Faith, Jesus Will Receive Us.
- 3. Jesus and the Girl Jesus Has Authority Over Death; We Can Have Peace As We Face The Future.
