"Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock," – Emphasis Changes From Paul To The Elders:

"Be on guard for yourselves" – "So guard yourselves"

1 Timothy 4:12-16

Effective ministry is not mere outward activity; it is the overflow of a rich, deep relationship with God.

John 10:16

"among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers," – The Holy Spirit is the one that calls one into oversight.

Overseers – (Bishop) – New Testament; there are three titles elder, bishop, (Overseers) and pastor, which were synonymous. The qualifications for this office are given in 1 Timothy 3:1-7, Titus 1:5-9.

The Aim: "to draw away"; Literally "drag away"

"the disciples after them." – True Christianity always points to Jesus Christ.

"Coveted" – "to set the heart upon, long for, desire, (after)"; It means a consuming and controlling desire for what others have and for more of what we ourselves already have.
