1. Verses - 27-31 The Sightless:

John 9:1-3

Blindness is a symbol of spiritual ignorance and unbelief:

Isaiah 6:10

Matthew 6:22-23

I Want To Observe Why The Blind Could See!

1. The Blind Sought Jesus: followed Him, Term followed – "to follow with intensity, used to describe the following of a disciple"

Crying out, the word was used to describe, "The croaking of a frog, the cry of a raven, cry out aloud, speak with a loud voice"

2. The Humility of The Blind: saying, "Have mercy on us, Son of David!"

Grace - deals with sin and guilt (pardons), cleanses & reinstates

Mercy – compassion for the consequences of sin

Mercy – "not giving what is deserved" **merciful -** is "grace in action"

6. Reward of The Blind: And their eyes were opened.

Lesson from the blind: Those that receive Jesus will see Jesus in new ways.

2. Verses - 32-34 The Speechless:

Demon-possessed, Literally "Demonized" under the control of one or multiple demons.

Matthew 9:33

Man Speaks For Jesus: And after the demon was cast out, the dumb man spoke;

Marveled - "to be in wonder, blow their minds"

Multitudes Speak About Jesus: saying, "Nothing like this was ever seen in Israel."

Matthew 9:34

Religious Speak Against Jesus: "He casts out the demons by the ruler of the demons."

Matthew 12:22-29

Lesson from the Demoniac: Those that have been touched by Jesus speak for Jesus.

Application:

- 1. The Seeking of Jesus will lead to seeing Jesus.
- 2. The Seeking of Jesus means we know our need for His mercy.
- 3. The Seeking of Jesus means seeking in persistence.
- 4. The Seeking of Jesus means faith must be personal, not merely intellectual.
- 5. The Seeking of Jesus and the touch of Jesus lead to speaking for Jesus.
