Jesus had just said He was leaving His disciples, John 13:33 – "<u>Where I am</u> going, you cannot come." John 14:1

#### John 13-17 – Private Instruction.

**The Thought Of Our Passage:** Jesus Is The Way To Follow, The Truth To Believe, The Life For Which We Hope.

<u>1. Verse 1 – In God We Trust</u> 2. Verses 2-3 – My Father's House 3. Verses 4-6 – Only One Way

# 1. Verse 1 – In God We Trust:

John 14:1

"Do not let <u>your</u> heart be troubled;" – Context: Jesus in the upper room has just predicted Peter's Fall, John 13:38. Now Jesus addresses all the disciples, "Do not let <u>your</u> (Plural) heart be troubled;"

Context – John 13 picks up with the question that Peter asked, John 13:36.

# These disciples had 3 reasons to be troubled:

- **1. Jesus Had Announced That One Of The Twelve Was A Traitor:** John 13:21.
- 2. Jesus Had Announced That He Was Leaving Them: John 13:33.

# 3. Peter Would Deny Jesus 3 Times: John 13:37-38.

Job 5:7

"Let not <u>your</u> heart be troubled;" – term "troubled" – "to stir or agitate." Literally, Jesus says, "Stop what you are doing, being agitated or troubled." Jesus had just been troubled Himself – John 13:21.

What Should We Do When We Are Troubled? We Must Trust In His Person, Jesus Is God: "believe in God, believe also in Me."

"believe in God, believe also in Me." – He is saying literally, "Look, I know that you trust God; trust Me also, you are trusting in God you are also trusting in me, keep on trusting in God and in Me, His Son."

"believe" – "speaks of trust; it is leaning and putting one's weight on Him."

# 2. Verses 2-3 – My Father's House:

John 14:2

#### 4 Reason's Not To Be troubled:

 Reason Not To Be Troubled – We Have A Home In Heaven: "In My Father's house"

Country – Luke 19:12; Hebrews 11:16 – speaks of its expanse, its magnitude, far reaching greatness.

Kingdom – 2 Peter 1:11 – the reign of a monarch, orderliness, authority, God's ruler-ship.

City – Hebrews 11; Revelation 21:1-2 – speaks of citizenship, population, those who belong to its dwelling.

Father's House – love, a family, the joys of a home where the fellowship of the Father is constant.

John 12:26

"In My Father's house" – It is for those that have a heavenly Father.

"are many dwelling places;" – KJV: "Mansions;" – "rooms, abiding places, or abode." Jewish culture, homes were added onto; when engaged, had a year to add wings. John 14:23 – "make Our abode."

"many places" – It is a real place. Luke 14:21-23 – "and still there is room."

Philippians 3:20-21; 1 John 3:2-3

**2. Reason Not To Be Troubled** – Our Personal Home In Heaven: John 14:2 – "<u>for I go to prepare a place for you</u>." **3. Reason Not To Be Troubled** – Jesus Will Return For Those Left Behind: John 14:3 – "I will come again and receive you to Myself,"

Jesus' Return Is As Certain As His Departure! "If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself," – Matthew 28:20.

"I will come again" – This would be the resurrection, and the rapture.

"Rapture": not the "Second Coming." The Rapture takes place at any time. Before the tribulation begins, Jesus is coming for us, 2 Thessalonians 2:3-8; 1 Corinthians 15:51-53.

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

John 14:3 - "that where I am, there you may be also."

**4. Reason Not To Be Troubled** – We Will Always Be With Jesus: "that where I am, there you may be also."

Revelation 21:3-4

# 3. Verses 4-6 – Only One Way:

John 14:4 – Speaking of the way to the Father in heaven; through the cross, Jesus must die and rise again.

Hebrews 12:2

John 14:5 – "Thomas said to Him," – "Doubting Thomas." Better called "Honest Thomas." This was a disciple that wanted to be with Jesus, John 11:16.

"Lord, we do not know where You are going," – Thomas professes ignorance to the destination of Jesus!

"how do we know the way?" – Thomas professes ignorance to the road to Jesus' destination.

John 14:6

Jesus who gives the answer is Himself the answer: "Jesus said to him, <u>I am</u>" – Jesus is declaring His deity. It is the same "I Am" in Exodus 3:14. The 6<sup>th</sup> "I Am" Of John's Gospel – "I am the way, and the truth, and the life;"

"I am the way" – To Salvation; "I am the way," – Way to the Father. This is the great question of the human heart: "How can I be saved?" I Am The Way! John 10:7

"The Way" – From the guilt of sin! How can sin be removed? How can I have victory over the power of sin? John 10:9

How Can I be Saved? I must admit that I am lost! I must cease from my own efforts, receive the one who said He was the way.

I Am The Truth – To Be Sure: "and the truth," – Jesus did not say, "I came to tell you the truth about the Father!" He came as The Truth. Not arrogant but true! In Himself, The Truth About God.

The great question of the human heart "How can I be sure?" I Am The Truth!

The Truth is Personal – God is a person.

I Am The Life – To Satisfaction: "and the life;" – Jesus said this because man is dead spiritually. He Provides The Life Of God.

Christianity is not a system of philosophy, nor a ritual, nor a code of laws; it is the impartation of a divine life.

John 5:21; John 11:25

"no one comes to the Father but through Me."
