1. Verses 1-5 - The Moral Depravity:

2 Tim 3:1

"difficult" - means "dangerous, hard to deal with, hard to bear, savage"

2 Tim 3:2

The Reason That Difficult Times Are Difficult: "For men will be"

There are <u>18 Ugly Characteristics of the last days</u>:

Root Issue – Self-Centeredness: "will be lovers of self, lovers of money," – "lovers of their own selves, self-lovers"; Verse 4 – "lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God;"

Matthew 22:37-39

- 1. Love Of Self "lovers of self," (Selfish); "lovers of their own selves, self-lovers"
- 2. Love Of Money "lovers of money," "money, the means for gratification of self" Luke 16:14 1 Timothy 6:10

- 3. Inflated Self-ward "boastful," "an empty pretender, a boaster, a bragger, vagabond, wanderer"; Self-love produces a boaster! Psalm 34:2
- 4. Inflated Man-ward "arrogant," "haughty, above all others", Gen. 3:5 Rom. 1:25; Matthew 11:29
- 5. Inflated God-ward "revilers," "blasphemers, given to contemptuous and bitter words" Rev 13:5-6
- 6. Disrupted Families "disobedient to parents," (Destruction of Society) Ephesians 6:1-2
- 7. Ungrateful "ungrateful," Children are "thankless, unthankful" Romans 1:21; James 1:17
- 8. Unholy "unholy," "profane" attitude; nothing is sacred, not revering or owing any duty to God.

2 Tim 3:3

- 9. Unloving "unloving," "without natural affection" is "family love"; Describes what should be apparent in nature but is not seen.
- 10. Irreconcilable "irreconcilable," (unforgiving) Greek word "Libation"; "a sacrifice to gods followed by a formal truce"; persons unwilling to try to agree.
- 11. Malicious Gossips "malicious gossips," (Devil's) In order to defend their position, they become "slanderers", "false accusers"
- 12. Without Self-Control "without self-control," "devoid of self government"
- 13. Brutal "brutal," "untamed, brutality"
- 14. Haters Of Good "haters of good," "no love for good men, no love for virtue, no love for that which is good or beneficial to others." Isa. 5:20

2 Tim 3:4

- 15. Treacherous "treacherous," "Traitors", describes people who betray others and cannot be trusted. Luke 6:16
- 16. Reckless "reckless," "Headstrong, high-minded, to raise a smoke, to wrap in a fog"; means "rash, acting without careful thought, those that fall foreword."

- 17. Conceited "conceited," "puffed up, High-minded", "puffed up"
- 18. Lovers Of Pleasure "lovers of pleasure" "Hedonism"; "pleasure is the chief end of man", rather than lovers of God; "controlled by pleasure"; Willing to make any sacrifice to fulfill the pleasures of their life.

2 Tim 3:5

"holding to a form of godliness," – "having a facade of religion"

1 Timothy 4:3

"and avoid such men as these." – "to turn oneself away from, to shun, to keep on avoiding" $\$

2. Verses 6-7 - Predators Of The Weak:

2 Tim 3:6

"enter" - "creeping in"; They use stealth; Religious sneaks.

"captivate" – "blind surrender of the will and conscience" weak described "weak-willed women, immature childish women"

"weighed down with sins," – "heaped up with sin"

2 Tim 3:7

3. Verses 8-9 - Opposing The Truth:

2 Tim 3:8

"And just as Jannes" – "he who seduces"; "and Jambres" – "he who makes rebellion"; opposed Moses, Exodus 7-9

"opposed Moses," - "set oneself against, to resist"

"men of depraved mind," – "tested and found counterfeit"

"rejected as regards the faith." – "disqualified as usable instruments vessels of God"
