"Children don't need to be adults to come to Jesus, but adults must become like children to come to Jesus."

Hebrew Culture Already Elevated Children – Genesis 30:1 – "Give me children, or else I die."

Hannah prayed for a child, Samuel – "God has heard"

This passage is recorded in Matthew 19:13-15; Mark 10:13-16; Luke 18:15-17

The Thought Of Our Passage: "Jesus Says Adults Need To Be Like Children If They Are Going To Enter The Kingdom Of God."

1. Verses 13-14 – The Advocate Of Children Is Jesus 2. Verse 15 – Children Model How To Receive Jesus 3. Verse 16 – Children Belong In The Arms of Jesus

1. Verses 13-14 – The Advocate Of Children Is Jesus:

Mark 10:13

"And they were bringing children" – The Context – Jesus has just spoken about divorce to the disciples, (Mark 10:1-12); now He speaks about children.

"bringing children to Him" – literally "bringing in waves, our groups to Jesus."

children – general word "an infant, or a half-grown boy or girl"; Luke 18:15 – babies "babe, suckling's, infant"; Matthew 19:13 – some

children, "little one, infant"; <u>We are speaking of infancy to possibly 3</u> <u>years of age</u>. Mark 10:16

In the Jewish culture the father was responsible for the spiritual training of the children.

"to Him so that He might touch them;" – Matthew said, "Lay His hands on them and pray." Gen 9:26-27 – Noah blessed Shem and Japheth. Gen 26 Isaac blesses Jacob, Esau; Genesis 48:14 – when Jacob laid his hands on Joseph's boys to give them a blessing.

Parents Should Bring Their Children To Jesus:

How does one bring their children to Jesus?

- 1. Through Prayer
- 2. Through Instruction

Eph 6:4

Deut 6:4-9

3. Through Example

Deut 6:4-6

Prov 1:8

"rebuked" – "to reprove, censure severely, reprimanded them, charge one with wrong"

Why did the disciples do this?

- 1. Disciples believed children were an interruption
- 2. Children Were Of Little Importance

Mark 10:14

<u>Jesus Loves All Children</u>: But when Jesus saw this, He was indignant – Literally "much grieved, to be very grieved, very angry, irate to severely reprimand"

Luke 18:16 – "But <u>Jesus called for them</u>," (Parents)

Jesus Christ, Advocate For Little Children!

Jesus performed many miracles on children.

Lesson On Discipleship: Never Hinder Children Coming To Jesus – "Permit the children to come to Me; do not hinder them;" – Literally "always let them come to me."

Mark 9:36-37

Children Have A Special Place In Jesus' Kingdom: "for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these." What is the kingdom of God? – "ruling and reigning with Jesus Christ, heaven, belonging to Jesus, entering life, everlasting life, being saved."

"to such as these." – Whole category, whole class of beings to which these babies belong. Literally, "The Kingdom of God belongs to these kind, babies, infants, little children."

Deut 1:39, Ezekiel 16:21 – my children (Pagan children sacrificed)

Babies before they reach accountability for believing or not believing, are under special divine care. 2 Sam 12:23 - "I will go to him"

Matthew, Mark and Luke all follow up this incident with the story of "The Rich Young Ruler", Mark 10:17

Babies Are A Powerful Illustration That Salvation Is By Grace.

2. Verse 15 – Children Model How To Receive Jesus:

Mark 10:15

"Truly I say to you," – Literally "This is of a great truth; listen up, this is important"

We Must Enter The Kingdom Like A Child: "whoever does not <u>receive the</u> <u>kingdom of God like a child</u> shall not enter it at all."

"shall not enter it at all." – Greek double negative – "shall never, never, enter"

What Characteristics Should We Learn From Children?

- 1. Children Are Teachable
- 2. Children Are Simple/Uncomplicated

- 3. Children Trust (Until adults mess them up)
- 4. Acceptance Of Authority
- 5. Humility
- 6. Children's Sense Of Wonder

3. Verse 16 – Children Belong In The Arms of Jesus:

Mark 10:16 Safety in His arms – Is. 40:11 "and began blessing" – "fervently blessed them" "laying His hands upon them." – Praying for them

Application:

- 1. Parents Are Responsible To Bring Their Children To Jesus. We Bring Them Through Prayer, Instruction And Example.
- 2. Jesus Christ Is The Advocate For Little Children. Before A Child Is Accountable For Their Actions, They Have A Special Position Of Belonging To The Kingdom Of God.
- 3. Lesson On Discipleship, Children Are Loved By Jesus So We Should Never Hinder Children From Coming To Jesus.
- 4. In Order For Adults To Enter The Kingdom Of God, We Must Learn From Children. To Be More Teachable, Simple/Uncomplicated, Trust God, Accept God's Authority, Humble One's Self, And Not Lose Our Wonder Of God.
