1 Thessalonians 5:12-28

Paul calls them "Brethren" 27x in 1 & 2 Thessalonians. Paul used it a total of 60X in his letters.

Brethren – is a term that is used to describe members of a family.

The Thought Of Our Passage: "Church Etiquette Involves Appreciation For Spiritual Leaders, Ministering To One Another, And Our Worshiping Of God In The Truth"

<u>1. Verses 12-13 – Honoring Our Church Leaders</u>:

1 Thess 5:12

"we request of you," - "We ask and beg you"

5 Facts Regarding Spiritual Leaders:

1. Spiritual Leaders Who Work Hard Should Be Appreciated: "that you appreciate those who diligently labor among you,"

"you appreciate" – KJV the word "Know"; Idea of looking at to really examine to interview, to find out; "to have regard for one, cherish, pay attention to"

"labor" – "to grow weary, tired, exhausted, to toil under burdens or with wearisome effort"

2. Spiritual Leaders Are Under-Shepherds Of God: "and have charge over you in the Lord"

1 Peter 5:2-4

"in the Lord" – (Submit To God And His Word)

3. Spiritual Leaders Are Required To Instruct God's People: "and give you instruction,"

1 Thess 5:13

 Spiritual Leaders Are To Be Honored And Loved: "that you esteem them" – "regard, to separate, to elevate, to place in honor"

Love Them: very highly in love

5. Spiritual Leaders Should Not Be Our Enemies: "Live in peace with one another."

2. Verses 14-16 – Caring For Those In Our Fellowship:

1 Thess 5:14

4 Groups Identified For Ministry For Believers:

1. The Unruly: "And we urge you, brethren, admonish the unruly,"

Eph 4:11-12

"admonish" – "warn" the unruly, "disorderly, out of ranks (often so of soldiers); deviating from the prescribed order or rule; Used in Greek society of those who did not show up for work"

 The Quitters: Encourage – "to speak to, address one, to calm and console" the fainthearted, "small-souled, denotes the despondent"

James 1:2-4

- 3. The Weak: 'help' "to hold up, hold on firmly, cleave to"; "the weak," "to be without strength, to be feeble"
- 4. All Person's: "be patient with all men."

1 Thess 5:15

Our Motives: "See that no one repays another with evil for evil,"

Romans 12:17

Romans 12:19-21

Be Joyful: 1 Thess 5:16

Neh 8:10 - for the joy of the LORD is your strength."

3. Verses 17-28 – Worshiping God Through The Truth:

1 Thess 5:17

5-Point Description of Genuine Worship:

- 1. Verse 17 Worship Through Prayer: "pray without ceasing" "constantly recurring"
- 2. Verse 18 Worship Through Praise: 1 Thess 5:18

Worship – is a response to who God is. Praise – is a response to what God does.

3. Verses 19-21 – Worship Through The Word:

1 Thess 5:19 – "quench" – metaphor "to suppress, stifle the divine influence of God"

1 Thess 5:20 – "despise" – "to think little of, or contemptible"

Worship that ignores the Bible (Divine Revelation) is not spiritual!

1 Thess 5:21

4. Verses 22-24 – Worship Through Dedication: 1 Thess 5:22

"form" – "the external or outward appearance, form figure, shape"

Negative – "Abstain" – "abstain from every form of evil."

1 Thess 5:23

Positive – Dedicate – "Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you entirely;" The term sanctify – "to separate from profane things and dedicate to God, to purify internally by renewing of the soul" 1 Thess 5:24

Phil 1:6

2 Tim 2:13

5. Verses 25-28 – Worship Through Fellowship: 1 Thess 5:25-27

"I adjure" – "to force to take an oath, to administer an oath"

1 Thess 5:28

Application:

- 1. We As A Church Fellowship Are To Honor Our Spiritual Leaders Because Spiritual Leaders Work Hard; Spiritual Leaders Are God's Under-Shepherds; Spiritual Leaders Instruct Us; We Are To Love Spiritual Leaders And Not Think Or Treat Them As Enemies.
- 2. Caring For Those In Our Fellowship Includes People Who Are Unruly, The Quitters, To Those Who Are Weak, And To All People In General.
- 3. Worshiping God Through The Truth Consists Of But Is Not Limited To Prayer, Praise, The Word, To Being Dedicated And To Fellowship.
