1. Verses 15-17 - How To Restore

The need of conversion: Matt 18:3

The need of humility: Matt 18:4

The danger of stumbling others: Matt 18:6

The great value of all believers: Matt 18:12

Stumble – "putting something in the way of someone else's obedience to God and so causing them to stumble"

Sins - "miss the mark"

Jesus Gives 4 Steps to Restore:

Step #1 – A Private Conversation: "go" – Greek present tense imperative mood – implying a gentle, patient series of confrontations

Matt 5:23-24

Reprove him – "Tell him to his face"; Bring to light, expose the offense. It suggests showing to the point of conviction.

1 Peter 2:23

Preserves Confidentiality:

We must come in love and want to love:

We need to get the facts: if he listens to you

Prov 18:17

What is the goal and purpose? You have won your brother.

We must approach conflicts with humility: Matt 18:4

Restore - "to set a broken bone"

Start Soon:

Step #2 – Take Witnesses: take one or two more with you:

Deut 19:15; Deut 17:6

- 1. Adding more people brings added loving persuasion to the person so they might see the seriousness of the situation.
- 2. Protects the sinner in negotiations less the demands of correction are excessive and misguided.
- 3. To provide two moderators in the case that one or both parties get confrontational making it personal, failing to see the error of their way.

Step #3 - Take it to the Church: tell it to the church;

Matt 16:18

Church – literal meaning is "a called-out assembly" The word is used 114X in the New Testament and in 90 of these references, a local church (assembly).

Step #4 – Break off the relationship: let him be to you as a Gentile and a tax-gatherer.
