"Double Healings" Mark 5:21-43; Luke 8:40-56 Matthews account is the shortest.

Jairus, his name means, "whom God enlightens"

Jairus faced 4 obstacles:

- 1. Pride and bowed down before Him, Luke 8:41 Literally "Begging repeatedly again and again."

The contrast between Jairus and the Woman:

1. Official - Had a respected position. Woman - Was an outcast.

2. Official - Was wealthy. Woman - Was poor.

- 3. Official Had 12 years of joy with his daughter. Woman Had 12 years of sorrow with sickness.
- 4. Official Had many friends. Woman - Was isolated, all alone.

Had in Common:

- 1. Both rich and poor had suffering in common.
- 2. Both had exhausted their resources.
- 3. Both beyond natural help.
- 4. Both needed Jesus.
