## 1. Verses 24-26 – Desperation:

"Tyre" - Literally - "The Rock" Sidon Matthew 15:21

Tyre is outside of Israel

Israel was never intended to be the end of God's saving purpose but the means to the end.

The reason our Lord came to Israel was to bring salvation to Israel so that Israel could be the means to Gentile salvation.

- 1. She Was A Woman "woman" The Jewish Culture was a male-dominated culture.
- 2. Her Nationality "was a Gentile, of the Syrophoenician race." Matt. 15:22
- 3. Jesus Seemed To Be Against Her "she kept asking Him.": "kept on begging"

"she kept asking Him," - "She repeatedly asked again and again of Jesus"
