We are all in need of Spiritual Protection:

1. No one is above falling:

1 Cor. 10:12

1. David -
2. Solomon -
3. Peter -

2. We need to know how to pray for spiritual protection for ourselves:

First 3 Petitions have to do with God's glory (God Side)

1. Honoring His name - "Hallowed be Thy name"
2. Advancing His Kingdom - "Thy Kingdom Come"
3. Doing His will - "Thy will be done"

Last 3 Petitions have to do with man's need (Man Side)

4. Provision - "Give us our Daily bread"
5. Forgiveness - "Forgive our debts"
6. Petition (God's Protection)

We will look at 2 areas this morning:

- 1. Lead Us Not Into Temptation:** (Negative)
- 2. Deliver Us From Evil:** (Positive)

1. Lead Us Not Into Temptation:

Matt 6:13

- It does not mean that God is the prime mover behind all temptation:

James 1:13

- Some believe that if you pray this prayer you will be delivered from all temptations:

1. Temptation – *"to bring out the worst, a solicitation to do evil, to lead or cause one to sin."* Which Satan is always behind.

2. Temptation – *"to bring out the worth, to test or place on trial to prove the validity of one's faith."*

Luke 4:1-2

Temptation – 21X In the NT and 20X have the idea of bringing out ones worth, to test.

Meaning: *"Don't allow us to come under the sway of temptation that will overpower us and cause us to sin."*

1. The Natural world is fallen:

- The lust of the flesh (Lust of Passions)

(We need to note that testing is good for us!)

2. Deliver Us From Evil:

NLT Matt. 6:13 – And don't let us yield to temptation, but deliver us from the evil one. *"Deliver us from the Devil, and evil also"*

- That a prayer for spiritual protection understands that the Devil is a real person –not an impersonal cosmic force

Matt. 12:28

Satan – *"Adversary"*

Devil – *"Slanderer"*

Eph. 2:2

2 Cor. 11:14-15

- That a prayer for spiritual protection confirms Satan's power, our weakness but God's greater power (Spiritual Warfare)

Eph. 6:11-18

1. The belt of truth -
2. The breastplate of righteousness -
3. Shoes of peace -
4. Shield of faith -
5. Helmet of salvation -
6. Sword of the Spirit -
 - It takes Prayer to put the armor on.
 - It is prayer that makes the armor effective.
 - It is prayer that causes the whole army to be victorious.

Application:

1. Humbly pray 'And do not lead us into temptation, We must empty ourselves of spiritual presumption.
2. We must pray but deliver us from evil. Knowing that victory over Satan only comes through God's power.

1 Corinthians 10:13
