**Theme –** Deuteronomy – "Renewed Covenant", "Second Law", "Beware lest you forget"

**Deuteronomy** – Man's Need to Obey God. The Encouragement To Obey is God's Goodness, God's Law as a Guide, God's Faithfulness, and Moses' Example.

## Deut. 7:1-16 - Separation Unto The Lord:

Deuteronomy 7:1

Notice Verses 1 & 2 begin with the same word – "when"; "2 and when the LORD"; It is not a matter of "if" God would do what He said, it is a matter of "when."

God's Side of the Covenant Involves 2 Things:

- 1. God Would Bring Them Into The Land That He Promised To Abraham and Their Fathers. "When the LORD your God brings you into the land where you are entering to possess it," (Deut 7:8)
- 2. God Would Drive Out The Inhabitants Of The Land.

"greater" – (more peoples) and stronger (more powerful) than Israel

God is showing Israel that they must rely on Him to give them victory; they would be unable to defeat them without Him!

<u>Israel's Side Consisted in 3 Main Commands:</u> Notice that they are marked with the words "you shall" – 6 times in verses 2-5

Deut 7:2

1. Israel "You Shall" Utterly Destroy The People: "then <u>you shall</u> utterly destroy them."

2. Israel "You Shall" Not Intermarry With The Nations: Deut 7:3-4

God wasn't prohibiting interracial marriage, He was prohibiting interspiritual marriages.
