### 1. Verses 1-11 - Dissension:

Acts 23:1

Acts 22:30

Claudius Lysias first mentioned in Acts 21:32

"looking intently" - Literally, "fasten his eyes"

"Brethren," - (Term of Equality)

"conscience" – means "to know with, to know together." Conscience is the inner "judge" or "witness"

Conscience does not make the standards; it only applies the standards of the person, whether they are good or bad, right or wrong.

Acts 23:2

"high priest Ananias" – The name was a common one but this particular High Priest was appointed by Herod in 47 AD and assassinated in 66 AD.

Acts 23:3

"you whitewashed wall!" - "You Bag of Bones"

Matt. 23:27-28

Jesus was treated the same way as Paul, but responded differently! John 18:22-23

1 Peter 2:23

"Sadducees" – name meant "righteous ones" Acts 23:8

"and the other Pharisees," - "separated one's or separated ones"

<u>Liberal (Materialist) Thinking: "If we cannot observe God we must discount Him"</u>

The Purpose of the meeting was to determine if Paul had committed any crime. Paul pinpoints the true issue, one of doctrine. The Doctrine of the Resurrection, that of a living Savior.

Acts 23:9-11

"Take courage;" – Jesus uses this phrase 5X in the NT. Paralytic, Matt 9:2; to the woman with the hemorrhage, Matt 9:22; the disciples in the storm, Matt 14:27; the upper room, John 16:33; now to Paul in his hour of need.

Philippians 1:12-14

Today, we live by faith, in God's Word. The Bible is where God has spoken and continues to speak.

How do we know God's will? 1 Kings 19:11-12
