- 1. To remind the Ephesians of the spiritual blessings they have in Christ Jesus (1:3);
- 2. To encourage them through his prayers on their behalf (1:15-23; 3:14-21)
- 3. To show them the nature of the Church (1:22-23; 2:11-22)
- 4. To challenge them to live as Christians (Ch. 4:1-3)
- 5. To prepare them for spiritual battle (Ch. 6:10-24)

**Theme** – "Riches In Christ" "The Wealth of the Christian"

**Key Words** – Grace - 12 times; Works - 8 times; Saved/Salvation - 4 times; Riches - 5 times; Heavenly places - 4 times; Walk - 7 times; Church - 9 times; Body - 9 times

- 3. Passive verb The Spirit does it.
- 4. Present tense Keep on being filled.

He now gives 3 evidences of being filled with the Holy Spirit.

- 1. Joy (Speaking to yourselves)
- 2. Thankfulness -
- 3. Submission subject A Greek military term meaning "to arrange [troop divisions] in a military fashion under the command of a leader". In non-military use, it was "a voluntary attitude of giving in, cooperating, assuming responsibility, and carrying a burden".
