## **Exodus 27:20-21 The Oil for the Lamps:**

Oil – Holy Spirit

1. The oil was the fuel and the lamp was the only light that the priests had to be able to see in the holy place.
2. The oil represents the Holy Spirit; that the Holy Spirit is the fuel, the power. The Holy Spirit gives light, illumination.
3. The oil was needed continually. We need God’s Spirit at all times.
