Exodus 32 The Sin of Israel:

Exodus 32:1-6 The Great Sin:

(Violation of the 2nd Commandment Ex 20:4)

molten calf; The god of strength, endurance.

Exodus 32:7-14 The Great Test:

Exodus 32:11-14 Moses' Intercession:

God's Glory, not Moses' personal gain; love for the people!

Exodus 32:14

changed His mind – The Hebrew word means “to grieve, to be sorry” (Gen. 6:6; 1 Sam. 15:29) and describes God's change of approach in dealing with His people (Jer. 18:1-12; 19; 26). God's character doesn't change, but God does respond to the prayers and confessions of His people.
