The Thought Of Our Passage: "Believers Must Personally Show Fresh Commitment And Determination, And A Renewed Concern For One Another."

#### 1. Verses 12-13 – Straighten-Up/Straightforward

## 2. Verses 14-17 - Pursuing Peace And Holiness

#### 1. Verses 12-13 - Straighten-Up/Straightforward:

Hebrews 12:12

"Therefore," – Discipline is from God our Father for His children. Hebrews 12:10-11

Verse 12 – Straighten-Up

Job 4:3-4

Isaiah 35:3

"hands that are weak and the knees that are feeble," – This is Jewish imagery of attitudes of discouragement and despair!

"strengthen the hands" – This is a command, "strengthen" literally means "straighten up, make upright or straight, lift up." A word by which we derive the English word "Orthopedic". The imagery is that of a man frozen with fear and anxiety.

Hebrews 4:16

Hebrews 12:2

"that are weak" – literally "hands which remain beside the body in inactivity."

"and the knees that are feeble," – "paralyzed knees"

Straighten-Up: Read the Bible, pray, fellowship with the godly, attend the services and help serve others!

Verse 13 – Straightforward Conduct

Proverbs 4:25-27

"and make straight paths for your feet," – "level, straight a path that the lame and disabled will make it on."

The Concern That All Should Finish The Race: "so that the limb which is lame may not be put out of joint,"

The Author Has Been Stressing Togetherness: Hebrews 3:13

Hebrews 4:1

Hebrews 4:11

Hebrews 6:11

Hebrews 10:25

"but rather be healed." – Jesus Christ restored the paralytic (John 5) to a normal walk by the power of His authoritative Word.

## 2. Verses 14-17 - Pursuing Peace And Holiness:

Hebrews 12:14

"5 Problem Passages In Hebrews"

Problem passage #5 – Defying the Word – 12:14-29 (Refusing To Hear) – 5<sup>th</sup> and final problem passage.

Pursue Peace: "Pursue peace with all men," – "Give peace a chase as if in a hunt, aggressive pursuit"; Hebrews 7:1-2 – Jesus Christ with His High Priestly title as "King of Peace."

David said - Psalm 34:12-15

Apostle Paul said – Ephesians 4:3

"with all men," - Matthew 5:44-45

Matthew 5:9

Romans 12:18

Pursue Holiness: "and the sanctification" – (Holiness) "a process of yielding our lives to God, and becoming righteousness." The believer reflects God's virtues!

Hebrews 7:1-2 – Jesus' High Priestly title as "King of Righteousness."

Positional Holiness: Hebrews 10:10

Present Holiness - Demonstrated: Hebrews 2:11

Completed Holiness: 1 John 3:2

"without which no one will see the Lord." - Romans 5:1

If A Person Is Truly Saved And Yet Not Growing In Holiness, There Is The Loss Of Spiritual Privilege, Not Salvation.

Verse 15 – Wrong Attitudes: Hebrews 12:15

"See to it" – literally means "oversight"; it is "looking diligently"; (Command is Plural) making it everyone's responsibility.

Galatians 6:1-2

#### 3 Negative Attitudes To Be Avoided:

1. Don't Waste God's Grace: "that no one comes short of the grace of God;" Hebrews 4:1

Hebrews 3:12

James 4:6

Both <u>justification</u> and <u>practical sanctification</u> are achieved by the grace of God, not through a system of legalistic works and temple observances. Hebrews 4:16

"one comes short of the grace of God;" – How does this happen? Unconfessed sin. Keeping oneself from the Scriptures. Mark 12:24

By isolating oneself from fellowship! Ephesians 3:17-19

2. Stop The Root Of Bitterness: "that no root of bitterness springing up causes trouble,"

# Moses Used The Image Of The Bitter Root, Apostasy/Idolatry – Deuteronomy 29:18

The verb "trouble" means "to crowd within"; To crowd out.

This Is A Call To Vigilance – Persons who miss God's grace and have fallen away are a bitter root!

3. Stop The Defilement Of Conscience: "and by it many be defiled;" Titus 1:15

"defiled" - The verb indicates "that which can stain or dye."

Verses 16-17 – An Example Of The Defiled: Hebrews 12:16

Sexual Sin: (The Body) no immoral; Greek word pornos we get the word pornography. Hebrews 13:4

Verse 16 – Esau's Sin Of Being Godless: (Soul) "godless person like Esau," – This word "godless" is based upon the Greek term for "threshold", outside the temple, or not belonging to God. A profane person thus "tramples on spiritual matters and treats them casually."

Esau's Physical Sin, Sold His Birthright: "who sold his own birthright for a single meal."

Genesis 25:34 - "Thus Esau despised his birthright."

Genesis 25:29-34

Verse 17 – Esau's Loss Of The Blessing: Hebrews 12:17

"afterwards, when he desired to inherit the blessing, he was rejected" – "was rejected" in that it was already given to Jacob.

"for he found no place for repentance, though he sought for it with tears." – "there was no opportunity for him to change his circumstances."

Hebrews 6:6

# Application:

- Drooping Hands And Weak Knees Have A Depressing Effect On Others. Despondency Is The Devils Tool, Not Only Hindering Us, But Depressing Others.
- 2. What Is Needed In The Christian Race Is Not Sudden Burst Of Energy But Steady And Persistent Exertion To Finishing Well.
- 3. A Believer Can Make A Decision To Disobey God For Materialistic Reasons And Find It Impossible To Reverse The Future Consequences Of That Willful Act.
