Series "How Great A Salvation" "Freedom From Defeat" Romans 8:5-17 Study-22

Paul, in our passage, is explaining this new life through the Holy Spirit. Romans 1-7 – Holy Spirit: 2X; in Romans 8 – Holy Spirit: 21X; More than any other chapter of the NT.

"Romans 8 begins with <u>No Condemnation</u> and ends with <u>No Separation</u>." Romans 8 is summing up Romans 1-7.

Romans 8:1-4 - Freedom From Judgment

Romans 8:5-17 - Freedom From Defeat

Romans 8:18-30 - Freedom From Discouragement

Romans 8:31-39 - Freedom From Fear

Thought Of Our Passage: "Being In Christ Produces A New Mindset, A New Life, And Living Differently As God's Child."

- 1. Verses 5-8 The Mind Of The Spirit
- 2. Verses 9-15 The Indwelling Of The Spirit
- 3. Verses 16-17 The Witness Of The Spirit

1. Verses 5-8 - The Mind Of The Spirit:

Romans 8:5 – "For those who are according to the flesh" – Context: Paul left off with "No More Continuance In Sin," Romans 8:3-4.

"who do not walk" – "habitual way or bent of life, life-style;" "according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit."

"For those who are according to the flesh" – Romans 8:5-8 describes those that are non-believers. Paul is contrasting the believer versus the non-believer.

Non-believer Mindset Is The Flesh: "set their minds on the things of the <u>flesh</u>," – 13X Romans 8:1-17, "unregenerate, or the non-believer," Romans 8:9.

Galatians 5:17; Galatians 5:19-21 – Irreconcilable conflict of flesh and Spirit!

One's Mindset Expresses Their Nature; They Think like this because they are like this.

Believer's Mindset Is The Spirit: "but those who are according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit." – The spiritual mind; It is the human spirit that communes with the Holy Spirit.

Romans 8:6 – Mindset has eternal consequences.

Non-believer Mindset Leads To Death: "For the mind set on the flesh is death,"

Believer's Mindset Is Life: "but the mind set on the Spirit is life" – The Holy Spirit is called "The Spirit Of Life," Romans 8:2.

"and peace," – Those who have trusted Christ enjoy "peace with God," Romans 5:1; Galatians 5:22-23.

Romans 8:7 – Non-believer Mindset Leads To War With God: "because the mind set on the flesh is hostile toward God;" – Isaiah 48:22

Romans 5:10

"for it does not subject itself to the law of God, for it is not even able to do so;" – Persons outside of Christianity think they are doing well but they are lost!

NLT 1 Corinthians 2:14-15

Pleasing Self Or Pleasing God: Romans 8:8 – To be "in the flesh" means to be lost, outside Christ. The root of sin is selfishness – "I will" and not "Thy will."

2. Verses 9-15 - The Indwelling Of The Spirit:

Romans 8:9 – "Spirit of God dwells in you." – This is what makes a Christian; The indwelling presence of Jesus Christ, Romans 8:16.

"But if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ," – This is being a Christian, John 14:23.

"he does not belong to Him." – This Holy Spirit life, and dwelling, separates us.

Romans 8:10 – "If Christ is in you, though the body is dead because of sin," – The body is mortal; subject to corruption.

"yet the spirit is alive because of righteousness." – The Spirit of God is alive and well. It is from God; Justification by faith, we have been made alive!

Believer's body, the very temple of the Holy Spirit, 1 Corinthians 6:19-20.

Romans 8:11 – "But <u>if</u> ("since") the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you," – To think that we have the all-powerful God of the resurrection dwelling in us!

"He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead" – Jesus was tortured and nailed to a cross. He was willingly made weak but now resurrected through the Holy Spirit.

"will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who indwells you." – We have received the Holy Spirit of power. Holy Spirit has sealed each believer, Ephesians 1:13-14; 2 Corinthians 4:16.

Romans 8:12 – "So then," – or therefore, what is the outcome? "brethren," – speaking to believers; "we are under obligation, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh" – We have no obligation to the flesh, because the flesh has only brought trouble.

Romans 8:13 – "for if you are living according to the flesh, you must die;" – The consequence of a life in the flesh is death.

"but if by the Spirit you are <u>putting to death</u> the deeds of the body," – "to kill someone, hand someone over to be killed." This putting to death is reckoning the old nature dead! Romans 6:11

Also reckon or sinful practices dead to - Colossians 3:5-7; Galatians 5:24.

Jesus spoke of this – Matthew 5:29; Mark 9:43.

"you will live." – Dying to your desires and the temptations of this world; He can enable us to "put to death" the sinful deeds of the body, Romans 6:12-17.

Romans 8:14

Proof Of Sonship Is Being Led By God: "For all who are being led by the Spirit of God," – The word "led" – The verb here means "willingly led, to be governed, to drive, to carry, being under His control" by the Holy Spirit. Galatians 5:18 – Holiness, Godliness, Galatians 5:22-25.

"these are sons of God." – This is a distinguishing mark of the Christian.

Romans 8:15 – "For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again," – 1 Corinthians 2:12; 2 Timothy 1:7.

"but you have received a spirit of adoption" – The word "adoption" in the New Testament means "being placed as an adult son."

"as sons" – The moment of conversion, there is a tie to the heavenly Father.

Believer's Awareness Of The Fatherhood Of God: "by which we cry out, 'Abba! Father!" – "Daddy, Daddy, Pa, Pa," Galatians 4:6.

3. Verses 16-17 - The Witness Of The Spirit:

Romans 8:16 – "Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit" – "joint testimony, corroborates;" Believer's Witness Of Being God's Children.

Believer's Witness Of Being In God's Family: "that we are children of God," – 1 John 3:14.

Romans 8:17 – "and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ," – when we were birthed into God's family, we became heirs with God.

"if indeed we suffer with Him" – Greek present tense, "suffering with Christ is continuous."

The Promise Of The Coming Glory: "so that we may also be glorified with Him." – The aorist tense "being glorified is instantaneous." After the cross comes the crown.

Application:

- 1. One's Mindset Expresses Their Nature. The Non-believer's Mindset Is Of The Flesh, The Believer's Mindset Is Of The Spirit. The Mindset Has Eternal Consequences.
- 2. The Indwelling Of The Spirit Means Being Led By God. It Is The Believer's Awareness Of The Fatherhood Of God.
- 3. The Witness Of The Spirit; The Believer's Witness Of Being God's Children; The Believer's Witness Of Being In God's Family.
