1. Verses 4-6 – Greeting And Blessing:

Revelation 1:4

"John to the seven churches that are in Asia:"

Revelation 1:3

"Seven Churches": The number "Seven" is the "number of completion, perfection"; Used 55X in Revelation

"Seven churches of Asia Minor" - Present day Turkey. Revelation 1:11

"Grace" – "God's unmerited favor of God's riches at Christ's expense"

"Peace" – "relationship of peace with God because of God's grace" (Our experience with God)

The Trinity In The Salutation:

1. God The Father (The Father Existed Eternally): "From Him Who is and who was and who is to come;" – "Who is"; "eternally existed and will always exist." Exodus 3:14

Hebrews 6:17 (Unchangeable Character of His Purpose)

2. The Holy Spirit (His Perfect Ministry): "And from the Seven Spirits who are before His throne" – 1 Corinthians 2:10

3. Jesus Christ the Son: "and from Jesus Christ," - Son of God

3 Descriptions Of Jesus Christ:

1. "The Faithful Witness" – "the faithful witness," – (Prophet) summarizing Jesus life – John 7:7

John 18:37

Prophet – forth-telling, and fore-telling, testifies.

"Witness" – Acts 1:8 is witness which means "martyr"; Jesus gave Himself.

2. "The First-Born Of The Dead" – "the first-born of the dead," – (Priest) First born refers "to priority, prominence, preeminence, the most important of all resurrected."

Colossians 1:15

1 Corinthians 15:20

Priest – Died for us – paid the price – Hebrews 9:28

3. "Ruler Of The Kings Of The Earth" – "and the ruler of the kings of the earth." – (King) (His future Reign Over The Earth)

Revelation 11:15

Psalm 72:11

Zechariah 14:9

"kings of the earth." - Philippians 2:9-11

3 Things Jesus Christ Did For Us:

- 1. Who loves us "To Him who loves us," Present tense, "who keeps on loving us." I don't know how He can but He does.
- 2. Released us from our sins "released us from our sins by His blood," (aorist tense) "once and for all released in or by His own blood."

Revelation 1:6

3. He Has Made Us Priests – "He has made us to be a kingdom, priests" – Not kings and priests but "A kingdom of priests".

Exodus 19:5-6

As priests, we minister on behalf of Jesus Christ – 2 Corinthians 5:20

2. Verses 6-7 - Outburst Of Praise:

"to His God and Father, to Him be the glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen."

This is the first Doxology – "offering glory and splendor to God"

"to His God and Father," - Jesus the Son has God as His Father. John 5:18

"to Him be the glory" – Divine attribute, "glory of God"; Summarizes all the divine attributes in His powerful radiance.

"and dominion forever and ever." – Divine attribute, "sovereignty of God"; Extent of God's might and active rule over all.

"Amen." – "Truth" or "Faithfulness"; Literally "be it true, or so be it."

Revelation 1:7

"Behold" - "look - see"

"He is coming" - 500 verses in the Bible speak of it. His return is mentioned every 25 verses in the NT. "I will come again" - John 14:3

"with the clouds," – In Scripture, clouds symbolize God's presence, with Israel, giving of the Law, or a scene of heaven. Daniel 7:13

I Thessalonians 5:1-4

Matthew 24:29-30

"even those who pierced Him;" – (Jews), Zechariah 12:10

"and all the tribes of the earth will mourn over Him." – (Unbelieving Gentile Nations), Matthew 24:30.

Jesus speaking to the High Priest Caiaphas – Matthew 26:64

"Amen." – "Truth" or "Faithfulness"; Literally "be it true, or so be it", Isaiah 65:16.

John 14:6

Jesus is called "the Amen", Revelation 3:14.

3. Verse 8 – Testimony Of The Almighty:

Revelation 1:8

"The Almighty" – 8X in Revelation – El Shaddai, "the Sufficient One, The Almighty God"; Genesis 17:1-2 – Speaks of "God's omnipotence; He is all powerful."

2 Timothy 4:8

- 1. Jesus Is The Faithful Witness Who Came To Witness To The Truth Of The Gospel Of Salvation. We Can Know The Truth.
- 2. Jesus Is The First-Born Of The Dead Having Preeminence As The Son Of God: John 11:25-26.
- 3. We Don't Fear The Future Because Jesus Rules Over The Kings Of The Earth. Jesus Wields All Power And Authority: Revelation 11:15
- 4. How Could We Ever Doubt God's Love And Care? Revelation 1 Says Jesus Loves Us, He Released Us From Our Sins, He Has Make Us A Kingdom Of Priests.
