Matthew 11:11

John 3:30 - "He must increase, but I must decrease."

Public Ministry: (3 years) John 1:19-12:50

Theme Of John – "Jesus: God And Savior"

Thought Of Our Passage: John's Goal Of Ministry Should Also Be Ours, "Jesus Must Increase, But I Must Decrease."

<u>1. Verses 22-26 – The Partisan Controversy</u> <u>2. Verses 27-36 – The Selfless Testimony</u>

1. Verses 22-26 – The Partisan Controversy:

John 3:22

"After these things" – What things is John speaking of? John 3:1-21 – Jesus' encounter with Nicodemus.

Jesus and His disciples came into the land of Judea. Israel was divided into 3 areas – Judea, Samaria and Galilee.

John 3:23

"John also was baptizing" – <u>Had to overlap because John had to point to</u> Jesus!

"Aenon" – which means "abounding in springs"; "near Salim,"

John 3:24 – "for John had not yet been thrown into prison." – Mathew 4:12; Mark 1:4; Luke 3:19. Only John covers this overlapping ministry.

John 3:25

"Therefore" – "What is the therefore, there for?" Jesus and John are overlapping ministries, both groups preaching/baptizing.

"on the part of John's disciples with a Jew about purification." – We would say, "What Is The Value of Baptism?" Which one is the right one?

John 3:26

"Rabbi, <u>He</u>" – (John's envious disciples don't even say Jesus' name) – "He who was with you beyond the Jordan,"

"to whom you have testified," – John had said, "Behold the lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world."

2. Verses 27-36 – The Selfless Testimony:

John 3:27

5 Truth's To Keep The Testimony Selfless:

<u>1. Verse 27 – God Sovereignly Gives To His Servants</u>: "A man can receive nothing, unless it has been given him from heaven."</u>

(NLT)1 Corinthians 4:7 – "For what gives you the right to make such a judgment? What do you have that God hasn't given you? And if everything you have is from God, why boast as though it were not a gift?"

Hannah's Song of Thanksgiving – 1 Samuel 2:7-8

Psalm 75:6-7

<u>2. Verse 28 – We Are Servants To Jesus Who Is Lord</u>: "You yourselves bear me witness," – John refers to his own teaching that he never pointed to himself.</u>

"that I said, 'I am not the Christ,' but, 'I have been sent before Him." – John recognized the subordinate and temporary character of his own ministry.

1 Timothy 6:6

"The measure of success for any ministry is not how many people follow the minister, but how many people follow Christ through the minister."

John 3:29

"but the friend of the bridegroom," John is not the bridegroom, Jesus is. John is the friend, master of ceremonies, bringing the bride to the bridegroom.

<u>3. Verse 29 – We Should Be Joyful When Jesus Is Magnified</u>: John 3:29

<u>**4. Verse 30 – Our Goal Should Be For Jesus To Increase:</u> "He must increase," – Literally "go on growing"; "but I must decrease." – Literally "go on decreasing." Genuine humility calls attention to Jesus Christ, not self!</u>**

5. Verses 31-36 – We Must Center In Jesus:

Verse 31 – Supremacy Of Jesus In Origin: "He who comes <u>from above</u> is <u>above all</u>, He speaks of the supremacy of Jesus Christ.

"he who is of the earth is from the earth and speaks of the earth." – This is speaking of John the Baptist.

Colossians 2:3-4

Verses 32-34 – Supremacy Of Jesus Word: John 3:32

"What He has seen and heard, of that <u>He testifies;</u>" – John 1:14

John 3:33

"that God is true." – The Testimony of Jesus Always Agrees With God! 1 John 5:10

John 3:34 – "For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God;" – This is the basis of Christian authority; it is Jesus Christ, God's spokesman.

Verses 34-35 – Supremacy Of Jesus In Resources: John 3:34 – "for He gives the Spirit without measure." (NEB) "so measureless is God's gift of the Spirit"

Colossians 2:9-10

John 3:35

Verse 36 – Supremacy Of Jesus In Life And Death: John 3:36

John's Last Invitation and Warning: There is no neutrality when it comes to Jesus Christ, you either receive Him or reject Him!

"He who believes" – literally "continues to believe." The belief that he speaks of is present tense; "in the Son has eternal life;" – Present possession.

"but he who does not obey (Rejects, disobeys) the Son shall not see life,"

"but the wrath of God abides on him." – This word "wrath" – "up-surging, it is a passionate expression of outrage against wrongdoing."

- 1. Like John, We Must Recognize The Subordinate And Temporary Character Of Our Own Ministry.
- 2. The Measure Of Success For Any Ministry Is Not How Many People Follow The Minister, But How Many People Follow Christ Through The Minister.
