There is no other man that is given this title in the NT but Timothy. So he alone is given this name. **2 Tim. 3:16**

This term is rare in the NT but common in the OT. It is used 70X in the OT.

"The man of God" – "describes someone that is set apart and gifted by God to speak forth His message, that is God's Word!"

but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God; Literally "Men of God moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God"

1. Verse 11 – What The Man Of God Flees From:

1 Tim 6:11

(Negative) But flee from these things; This word flee – we get our word "Fugitive"; It means "to keep on fleeing"; Daily fleeing!

It describes a continued lifestyle a manner of life. It is used in extra biblical material of a person running from a plague, running from a poisonous serpent, running from an attacking enemy. He is running out of a healthy fear.

(Negative) But flee from these things; (Positive) and pursue (Follow after); "Speaks of always running after, always in pursuit."

``Some Christians flee without following, whereas others follow without fleeing."

and pursue Righteousness – (Outside a man)

righteousness; "It is speaking of our conduct, attitude, words out of our mouths; it is to follow the example of Jesus, who was the model of righteousness. We are to try and be like Jesus. It is our life."

godliness; (inside a man) "character of the man, a worshipping heart. He lives his life in full view of God; God is watching."

faith; "Loyalty to the Lord"; Devotion to God's purposes, God's plan. We are trusting God for his promises.

Sustaining Faith – No Panic, no manipulation, no schemes and plans but simple trust in the Lord and in His promises.
