This Prayer is a Pattern that reveals the "Priorities of Prayer"

The first three petitions: (God Glory) The Re-alignment.

1. "Hallowed be Thy name" - Honoring His name
2. "Thy Kingdom Come" - Advancing His Kingdom
3. "Thy will be done" - Doing His will

Last 3 Petitions: (Man Side) The Result.

4. "Give us our Daily bread" - Provision
5. "Forgive our debts" - Forgiveness
6. "Lead us not ... deliver us " - Guidance & Deliverance

1. Thy Name:

The term "The Name" is a reference to His nature, His character and His attributes and all that He is.

This is not esteeming the letters of His name! Philippians 2:9-11

Psalm 20:7

Jehovah – "Redeemer"

Jehovah Shalom – "The Lord Our Peace"

Adonai - "Lord" Is He your Lord?

Jehovah Jirah - "The Lord will provide"

Elohim – "God as Creator"

Hallowed – Old English word that means “To set apart as holy, to treat as holy, to reverence and set apart as saintly.” Hallowed is the word from which we get our term saint!

Proverbs 18:10

1. Some say that this is not a petition but it is adoration, it is worshipping God.
2. Others say it is a petition, to honor Him. Our prayer should be to honor Him. (The Name)

God is holy what does that mean? Negative, and Positive.

The Negative - absence of sin; The Positive – the essence of goodness, or righteousness.

How Can I Hallow God's Name?

1. Negative – Don't take His name in vain.
2. Positive – We reverence Him in our public and private worship.
3. We hallow Him when our beliefs concerning Him are worthy of Him.
4. We hallow His name when our lives display the Father.
5. We hallow His name when we are aware of His presence –
Psalm 16:8
